Key agencies at next Fiskville hearings

The parliamentary inquiry into the CFA training college at Fiskville continues with a series of public hearings on 19, 20 and 23 November.

Regulatory agencies, including the Environment Protection Authority, WorkSafe and Emergency Management Victoria, will be questioned by the Environment, Natural Resources and Regional Development Committee.

The Committee will also hear from the Moorabool Shire Council, which is the local government authority for the Fiskville area.

“This next round of hearings will see the detailed questioning of some of the agencies involved with safety issues and their knowledge of and responses to events at Fiskville,” said Committee Chair Bronwyn Halfpenny.

“We will also be asking questions about the way in which neighbouring property owners have been dealt with over the course of events at Fiskville.”

The public hearings will be held in the Legislative Council Committee Room in Parliament House.
