Workplace surveillance inquiry's final hearing

A parliamentary inquiry into workplace surveillance in Victoria wraps up public hearings this week.

The Victorian Government, Victorian Chamber of Commerce and Industry and WorkSafe are set to be represented throughout the day.

A panel comprising education, health and other sector unions is also scheduled.

A separate panel focused on workplace surveillance by non-employers will involve the Victorian Farmers Federation and Independent Education Union, Victoria Tasmania.

“Our inquiry has already gathered some really valuable information, and we look forward to listening to more evidence from these witnesses at our final public hearing on Friday,” Committee Chair Alison Marchant said.

“Next, we’ll prepare a report for government with findings and recommendations, which will be tabled in the parliament in 2025.”
