If we think things are starting to develop or the flags are going to go up, then we will get some of the RSL and they will start following this checklist step by step, and off we go.

MONBULK EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT GROUP (MEMG)

The Monbulk township is situated in the Dandenong Ranges, 269 metres above sea level and is within the Shire of Yarra Ranges. The population is estimated to be approx. 3000 residents with this number changing during the picking and growing seasons due to an influx of backpackers and tourists. The town itself is situated 42 kilometres east of the City of Melbourne.

The township comprises of a moderately sized shopping and business area which supports two major supermarkets, an RSL, Bowling club, numerous smaller shops, a Caltex fuel station, three doctors' clinics and a range of sporting clubs of which the Monbulk Ranges Soccer Club is now situated away from the town center the same being for the Monbulk Pony Club and Churches.

Monbulk has both Police and Fire Stations. The Police Station is staffed with a team of local police members. The Monbulk Fire Brigade has approx. 45 volunteer operational members with firefighting, heavy rescue, and rope rescue qualifications. The brigade's resources include; two Tankers, a Heavy Rescue, Rescue Support and Feeding Trailer that is run by the Auxiliary. The Fire Station is fitted with an EMV Community Alerting Siren that is designed to sound for 5 min to warn residents of an immediate threat during an Emergency. This will let residents know to seek further information.

The community's designated "Neighborhood Safer Place" in the Monbulk Football Ground and old soccer ground that is located off Moores Rd. This is not a "Fire Refuge."

PURPOSE:

This group has been formed to support community and government agencies during wide scale emergencies where immediate practical assistance cannot necessarily be provided during, or in the immediate aftermath (up to 72hrs) of an emergency. It is thought that the most likely event to affect the area will be, but not limited to, bushfire and storm events. MEMG was founded after recommendation from EMV (Emergency Management Victoria) and is endorsed by them and the Shire of Yarra Ranges.






