

CFA Emergency Management – Career Development Promotional Programs & Assessments (PPA)



The Candidate Course and Assessment process for Leading Firefighters (LFF) is conducted over a Three (3) month period. Candidates must submit a separate training nomination for each of the Candidates Program, Workshop Day and Assessment. Candidate courses are scheduled throughout the year as per F&EM Operational requirements, in consultation with Statewide Operational Training.

The Candidate Course & Assessment pathway is as follows:

- •36 Months on Station

- •Self, On Station & Shift Development
- •LFF Pre-requisite Training Modules

LFF Promotional Program

- •36 48 Months
- •LFF Candidate Course (Three Weeks)
- •Further on Station Development & Mentoring
- Workshop Day (Command & Control/TEWT)

LFF Assessment

- •LFF Assessment (One Week)

- •Non Core Modules Human Resource Management, In Tray, Administration Legislation & Short Duration Drill
