Having a guaranteed response would mean a good support of Appliances and manning for the Maiden Gully Fire Brigade and Community, This would really support the Maiden Gully Fire Brigade and take the pressure of members who volunteer their services.

I am Certain employing all career firefighters in one fire service will not affect Volunteer turn outs or surge capacity, I as a Volunteer look forward for this new fire service as a great step forward for a great fire service here in Victoria to protect the community.

I am sure the Volunteer support would be maintained with operational firefighters operation Officers and Operational Managers being employed by FRV but continuing their roles through an arrangement with CFA would not affect the volunteer support in CFA.


