Firefighters' Presumptive Rights Compensation and Fire Services Legislation Amendment (Reform) Bill 2017

I note the announcement to create the Emergency Services Infrastructure Authority.

It is disappointing that very little information about the new authority has been made available. The only information readily obtainable about the new authority is that ESIA will be responsible for delivering built infrastructure for CFA, FRV and other emergency services.

The creation of the new authority provides an opportunity to create a new organisation to support all of Victoria's emergency services infrastructure needs, not just land and buildings.


The responsibility of ESIA should be expanded to include all infrastructure, namely:
