



## Effective Management of Fire

#### \$43.7 million for Effective Management of Fire

#### Reducing fire risk: expanding the planned burning program

- Our Government will provide \$35.1 million in 2012-13 to increase the planned burning program to 250 000 hectares and to begin planning towards the 390 000 target
  - \$24.5 million in output funding
  - \$10.6 million in asset funding
- This puts our Government on track to meet the recommendation of the 2009 Victorian Bushfires Royal Commission to increase planned burning to 390,000 hectares.

#### Providing fire risk mapping data free of charge

- Our Government will provide \$8.6 million over four years to providing mapping data free of charge to emergency response agencies
- This implements recommendation 16 of the 2009 Victorian Bushfires Royal Commission.

## Effective Management of Victoria's Land Assets

#### \$13.7 million for Zoos

#### Zoos Victoria asset management strategy

- Our Government has provided \$13.7 million for Zoos Victoria to implement the first stage of its asset management strategy.
- This will provide
  - a rainforest exhibit commemorating the 150th anniversary of the Melbourne Zoo
  - an upgrade to the lion exhibit at Melbourne Zoo
  - an expanded safari fleet and upgraded arrival facilities at Werribee Open Range Zoo.

## Effective Water Management and Supply

# \$100 million for Effective Water Management and Supply across the Environment and Water Portfolios

#### Securing Priority Waterways: Regional on-ground works

- \$59.3 million over four years to improve the environmental condition of Victoria's high priority regional rivers, wetlands and estuaries.
- The initiative will focus on physical works across regional Victoria and conduct statewide policy coordination and planning
- Catchment Management Authorities primary delivery agent shared between Minister for Water and the Minister for Environment and Climate Change.

#### Management of environmental entitlements and onground delivery

- \$40.7 million to ensure effective management, monitoring and reporting of the environmental water reserve.
- This initiative will help restore the balance of water consumption and maximising the efficiency and effectiveness of environmental water use
- Environmental Water is managed by the Victorian Environmental Water Holder which is a legislative responsibility of the Minister for Environment and Climate Change.

## Operational Efficiency

- The 2012-13 Budget:
  - \$30 million in 2012-13 in efficiencies for the Environment and Water portfolios
  - efficiencies total approximately \$140 million over four years.
- Savings measures include:
  - head office, non-service delivery administrative savings, stocks and materials
  - professional services and contractors, employment agency staffing
  - reduction in portfolio wide discretionary grants programs not aligned to government priorities
  - Land Victoria system consolidations and efficiencies
- The Department will work towards minimising community impacts
