The current roles of Victoria's commercial trading ports

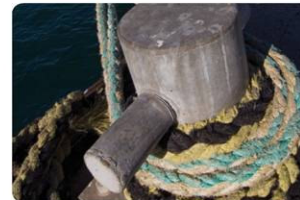


Trade growth at regional ports

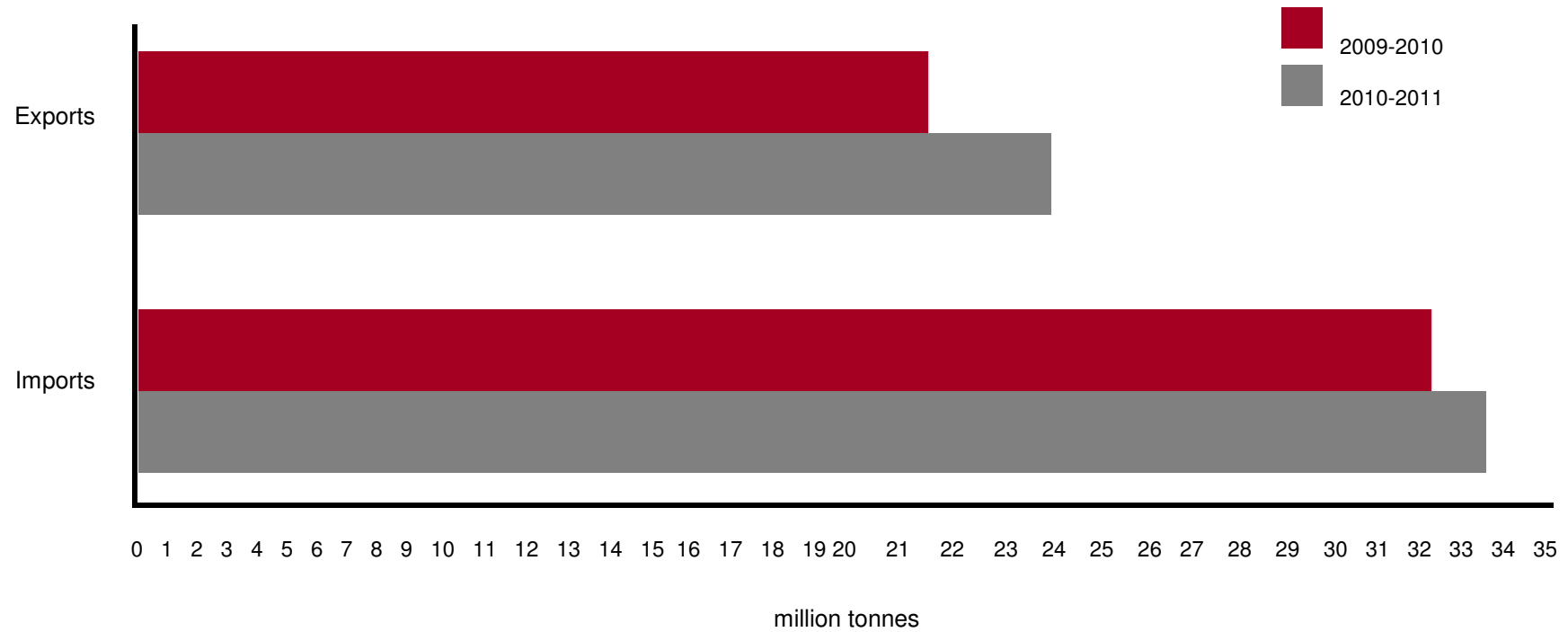

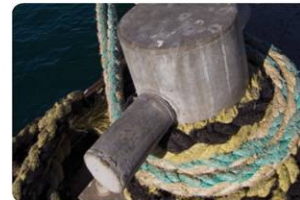


Trade growth at Port of Melbourne

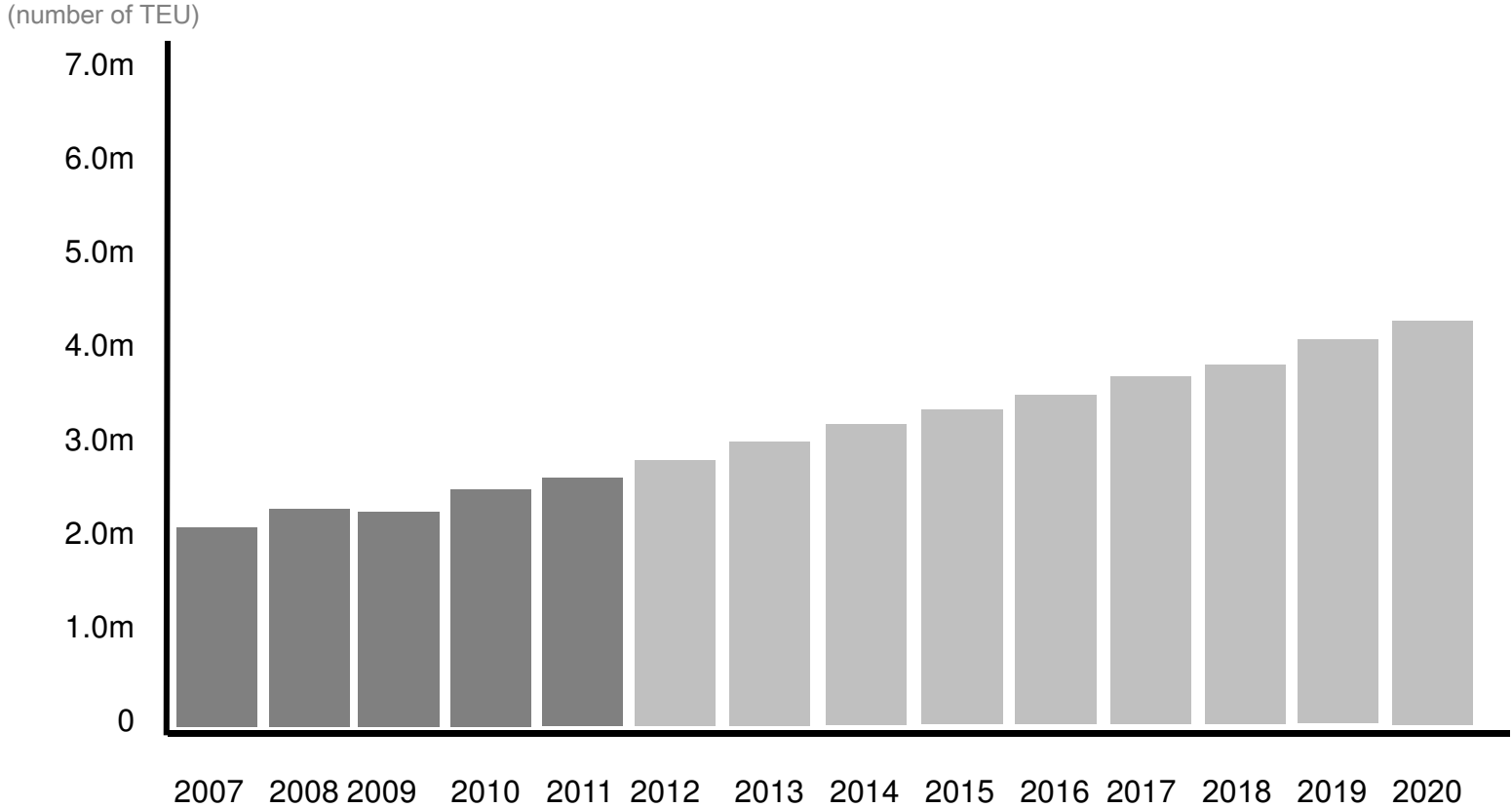

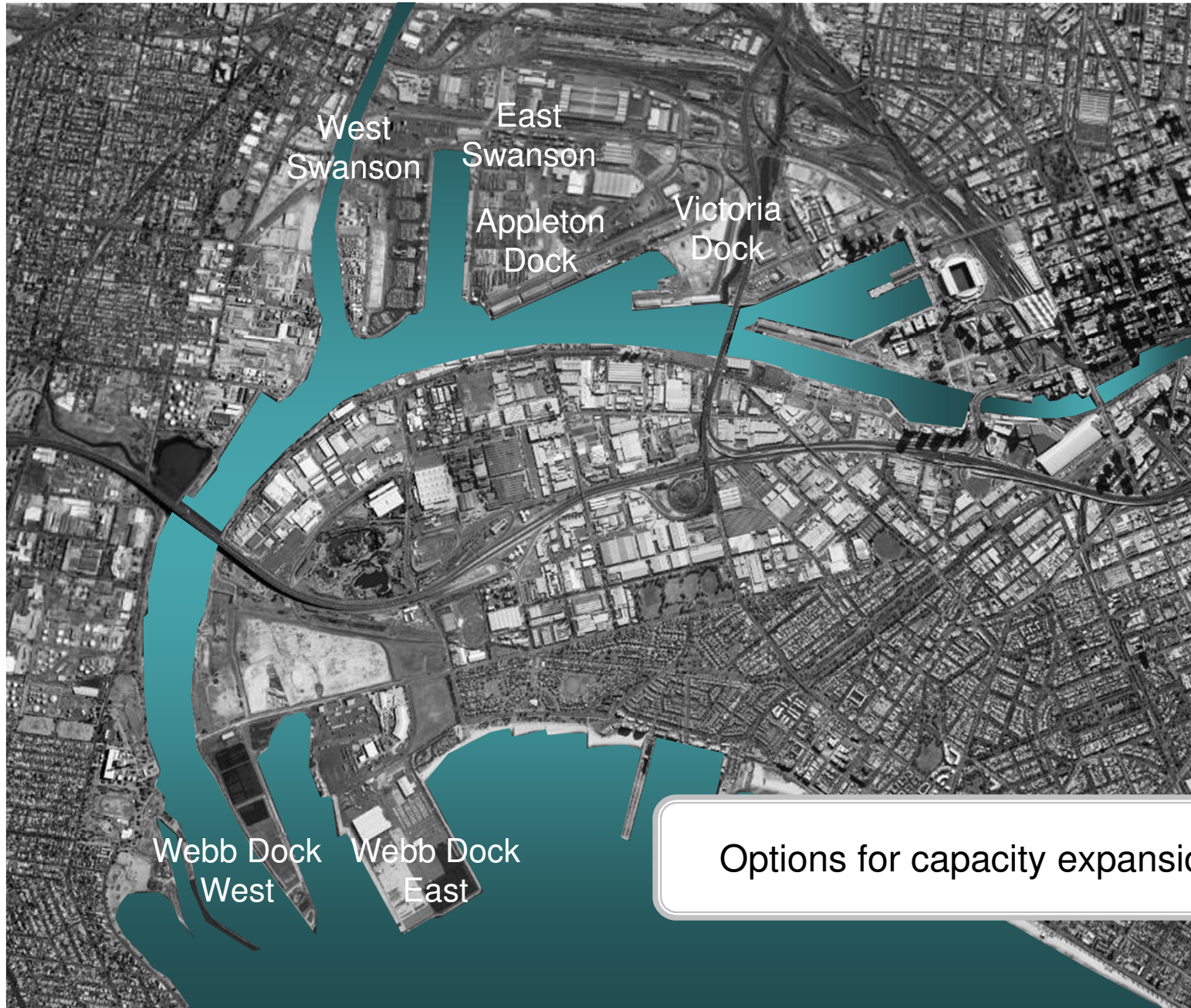
Two-pronged strategy to expand container capacity

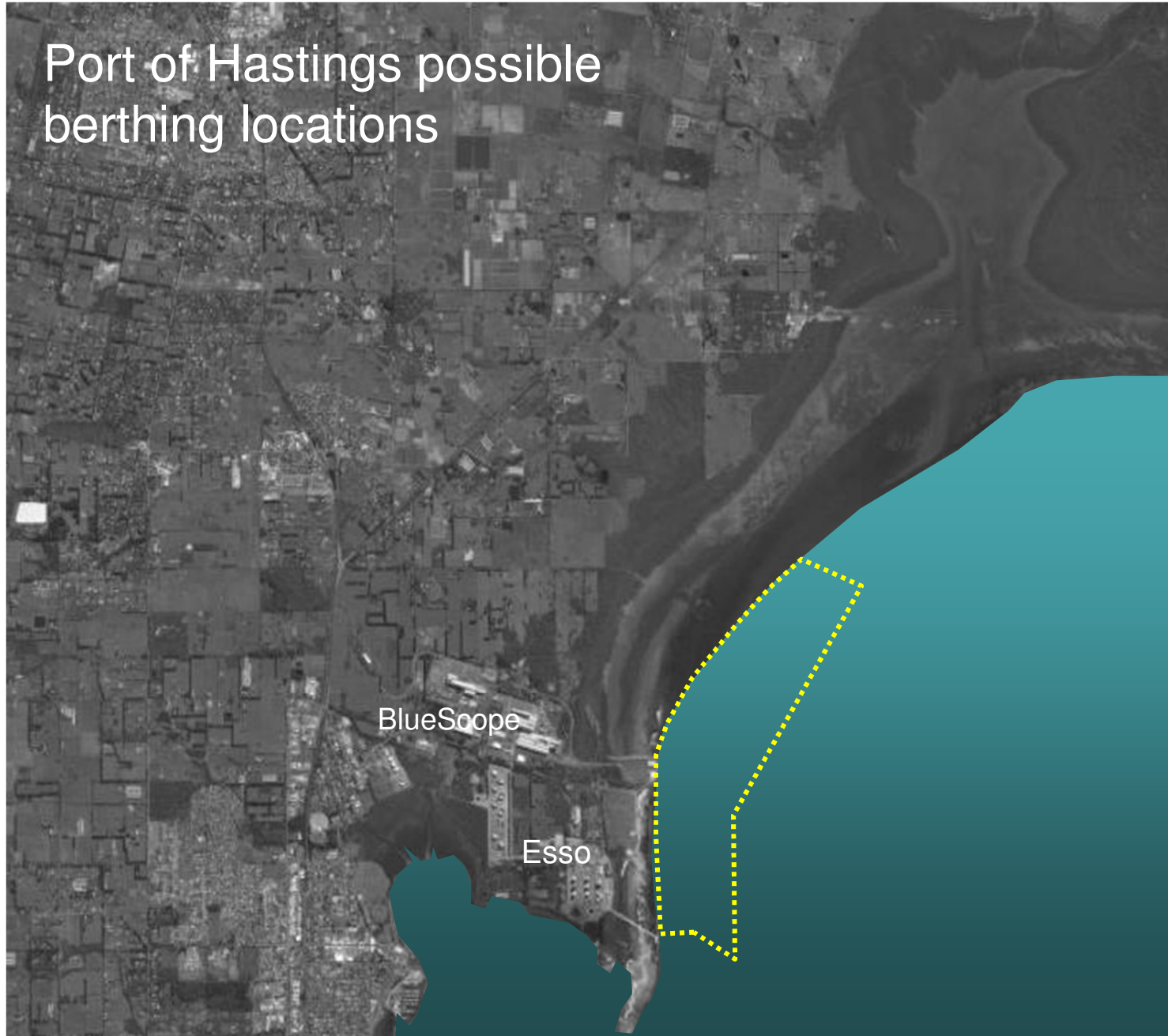

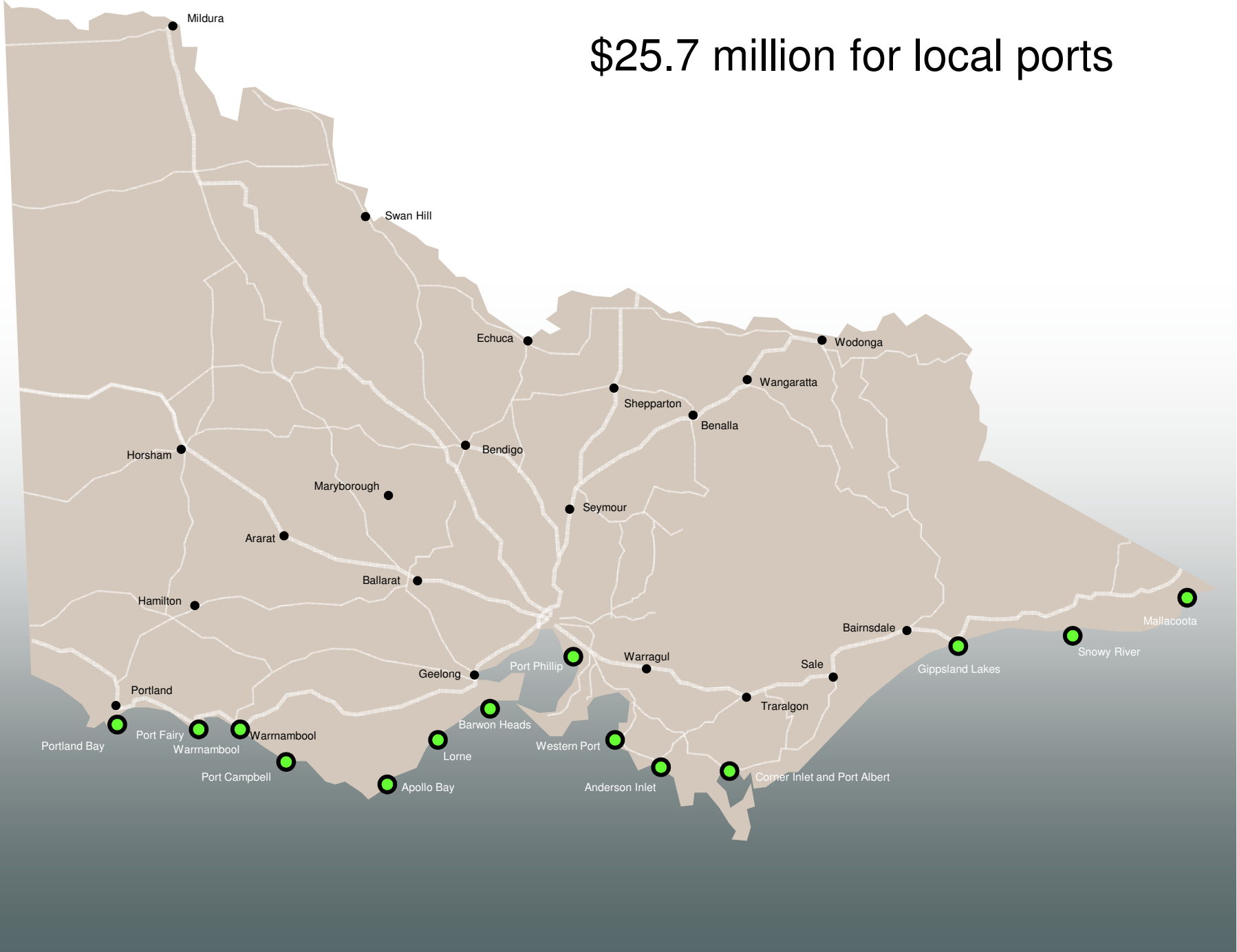
