Question Asked:

Do you have a handle on the costs to each of the CMAs of the last major flooding event for re-establishment of banks and infrastructure and stuff that CMA –

Camille WHITE: We would have to take that notice.

Response:

The North Central CMA can provide flood damage information relating to the North Central CMA works. The North Central CMA have received approximately \$5,845,000 for flood recovery works that has been used to undertake flood damage assessments, some riparian works such as fencing, revegetation and weed control, erosion control, surface drainage works and refurbishment to critical groundwater monitoring.
