Public Service

- 40 Departments and Offices
- **37,942 (34,798 FTE)** employees

Public Entities

- 3366 Public Entities
- 239,728 (188,168 FTE) employees
- The public service plays a crucial role in the lives of Victorians, supporting the wellbeing, security and prosperity of the State
- The Government reached agreement for a new Victorian Public Service enterprise agreement in December 2015
- The VPS agreement includes improvements to management processes, culture, workplace policies (including misconduct and underperformance, and family violence leave)
