



Investing in regional rail

- \$613 million over four years to fund larger maintenance projects to ensure performance is maintained.
- Investments in South Dynon maintenance facility & Lydiard St Level Crossing
- \$27.8 million to upgrade high-demand, freight-only lines



Investing in buses

- New funding to ensure students can continue to get to school in Shepparton and Horsham by bus.
- Improvements to bus networks in the Yarra Valley and Broadmeadows
- Extensions to bus routes in Clyde and Clyde North.
- New bus routes in Tarneit North.
- Additional services on route 505 between Moonee Ponds and Melbourne Uni.



Investing in accessibility

- Braille plates, tactile ground surface indicators, better lighting, weather protection and road markings for around 1200 tram stops.
- Planning for Tram Stop upgrades around Metro Tunnel stations.
- Upgrades to Windsor, Aspendale, Burnley and North Richmond train stations
