Hearings this week for electric vehicles inquiry

The parliamentary inquiry into electric vehicles will hold its first public hearings this week.

The public hearings will be in the Legislative Council Committee Room at Parliament House, commencing at 9:45 am on Wednesday 8 November and 9:30 am on Thursday 9 November.

The Economy and Infrastructure Committee will hear from a range of organisations, including automobile associations, companies operating in the electric vehicle industry, and local government.

The Committee is examining the benefits – or otherwise – of electric vehicles in Victoria, including manufacturing and applicability.

The inquiry will help to identify some of the environmental, regulatory, infrastructure and employment options that can be considered in relation to electric vehicles.
