Hearing examines CBD disruption from infrastructure projects

This Friday 15 September, the Economy and Infrastructure Committee will hold the next public hearing for its inquiry into infrastructure projects.

The focus for the hearing will be disruption in Melbourne's CBD arising from major infrastructure works, particularly the Melbourne Metro Rail project.

The public hearing will be held in the Legislative Council Committee Room at Parliament House from 10:00 am to 5:00 pm.

Melbourne Metro Rail Authority CEO Evan Tattersall, Transport for Victoria Head Gillian Miles and Public Transport Victoria CEO Jeroen Weimar will be among those presenting to the Committee.

Under its terms of reference the Committee considers and reports, at least once every six months, on public sector infrastructure and public works projects, including current infrastructure projects and proposals.
