## Further hearing on CBD disruption from infrastructure projects

This Wednesday 20 September, the Economy and Infrastructure Committee will hold a further public hearing for its inquiry into infrastructure projects.

Under its terms of reference the Committee considers and reports, at least once every six months, on public sector infrastructure and public works projects, including current infrastructure projects and proposals.
