## Health and transport focus for hearings on

## infrastructure projects

The Victorian Parliament's Economy and Infrastructure Committee will conduct two days of public hearings next week for its inquiry into infrastructure projects.

The public hearings will be held on Tuesday 18 and Wednesday 19 October at Parliament House.

Tuesday's hearing will be held in the Knight Kerr Room from 12:30 pm. Organisations giving evidence to the Committee will include Bendigo Health and the Australian Medical Association Victoria.

Wednesday's hearing will be in the Legislative Council Committee Room from 9:00 am with the Victorian Heart Hospital, Infrastructure Victoria and Melbourne Metro Rail Authority among the organisations presenting to the Committee.

Under its terms of reference, the Committee considers and reports, at least once every six months, on public sector infrastructure and public works projects, including current and past infrastructure projects and proposals.
