## Hearings commence on restricted breed dogs

The Victorian Parliament's Economy and Infrastructure Committee is commencing public hearings next week for its inquiry into the legislative and regulatory framework relating to restricted breed dogs.

On Tuesday 20 October the hearing will be from 11:30 am to 1:15 pm in Room G7/8 at 55 St Andrews Place, East Melbourne.

Witnesses will include Bill Bruce who served as Director of Animal and Bylaw Services in Calgary, Canada, where he developed a community model for responsible pet ownership.

On Wednesday 21 October the hearing will be from 7:00 pm to 8:00 pm in the Knight Kerr Room at Parliament House and will be with the Knox City Council.
