



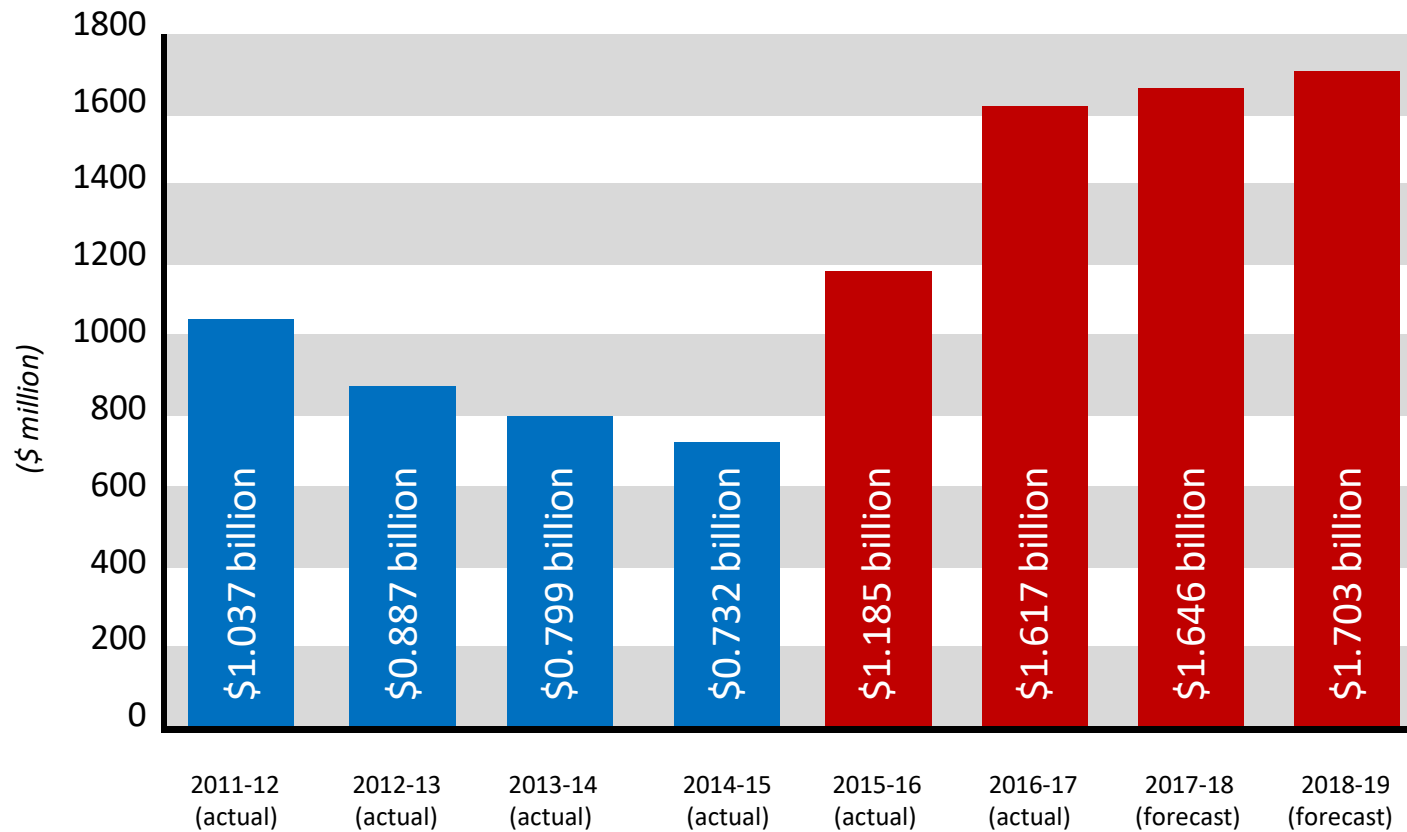

BETTER ROADS TO GET YOU HOME SAFER AND SOONER

\$4.3 billion for better roads around Victoria

- \$2.2 billion for North and South Eastern Roads Upgrades
- \$941 million for regional roads
- \$116 million to repair roads across metropolitan Melbourne
- \$110 million for the planning stages of the North East Link
- \$22 million for active transport initiatives
- \$21 million to strengthen bridges across Victoria

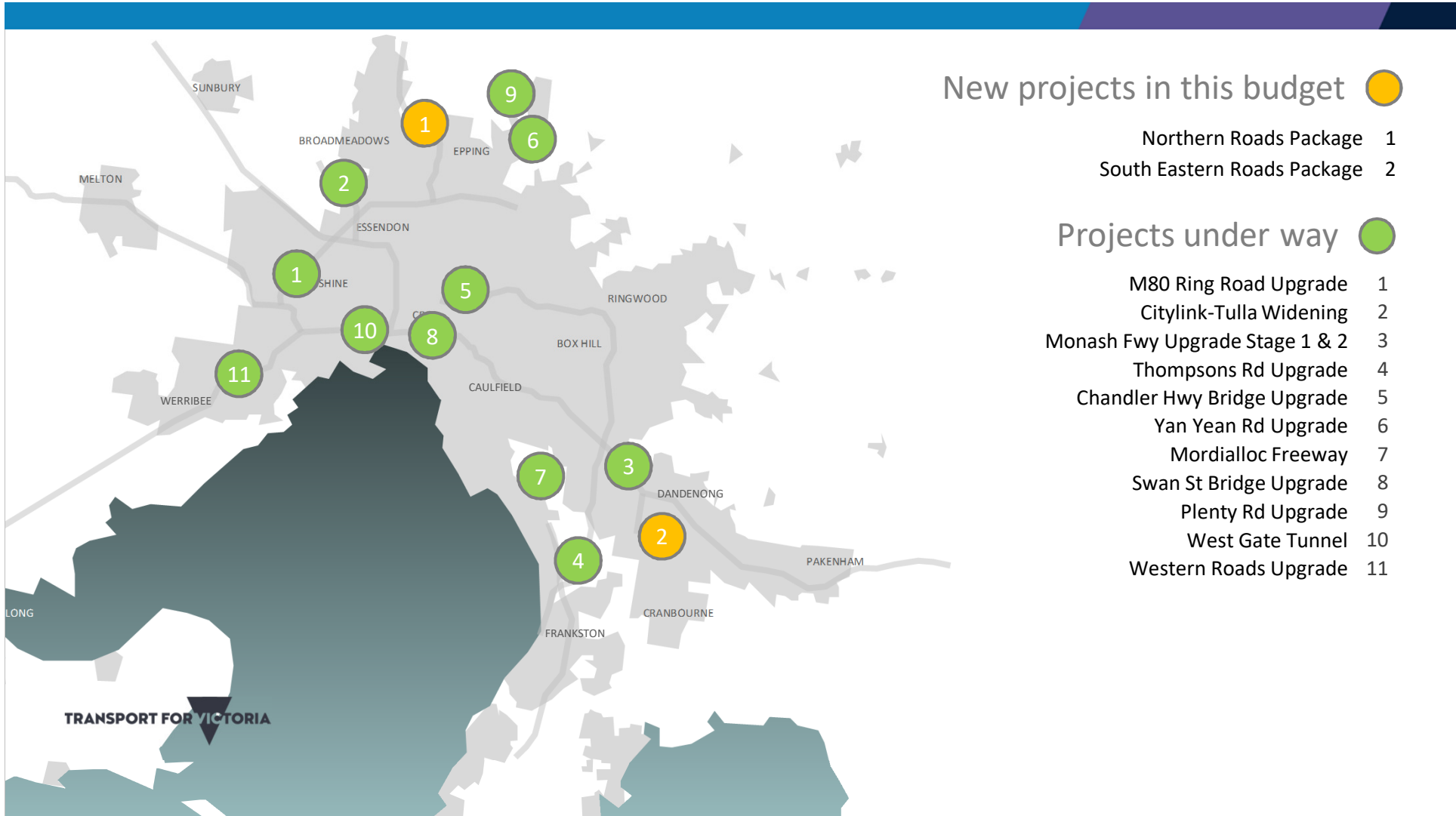

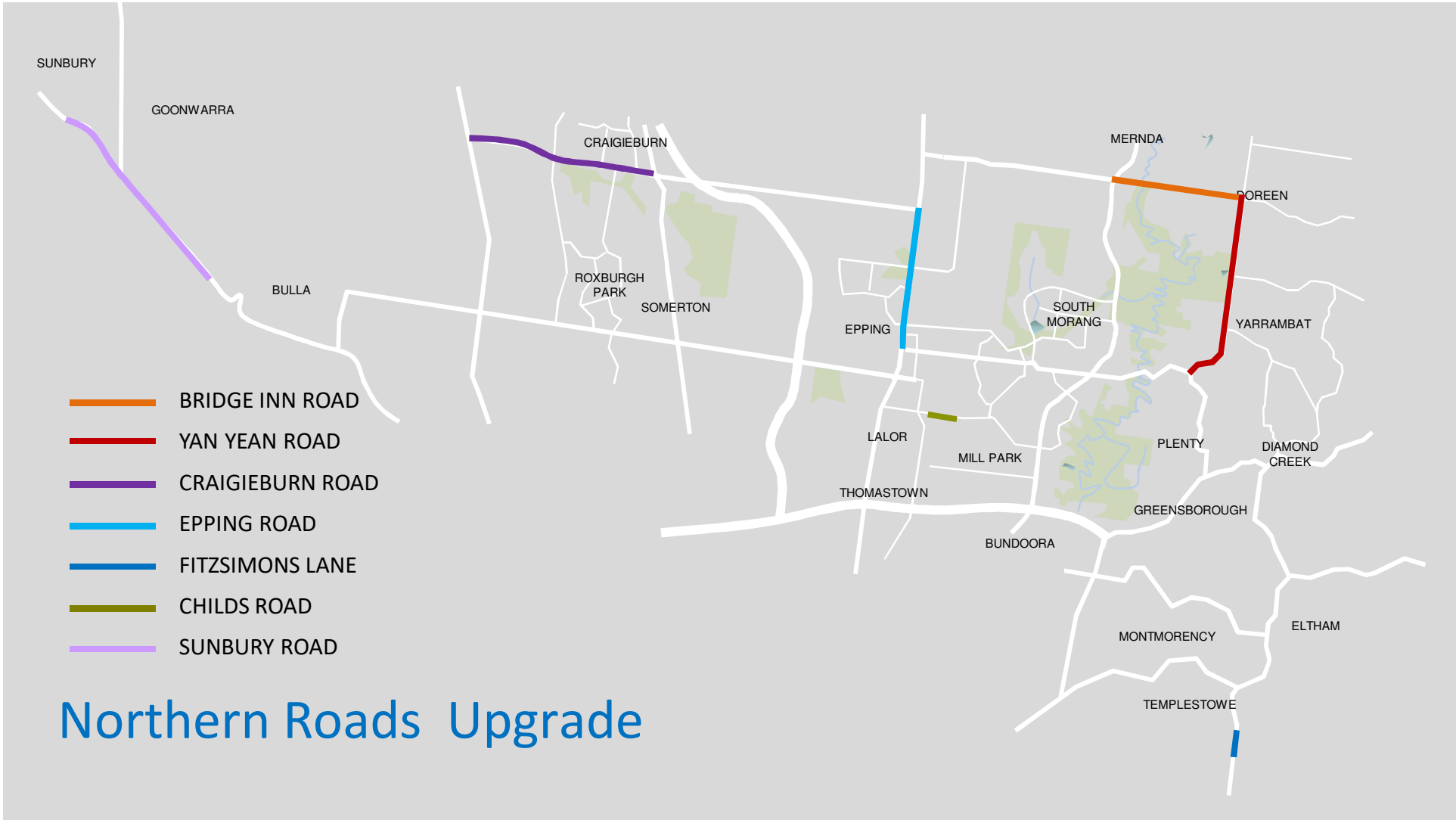

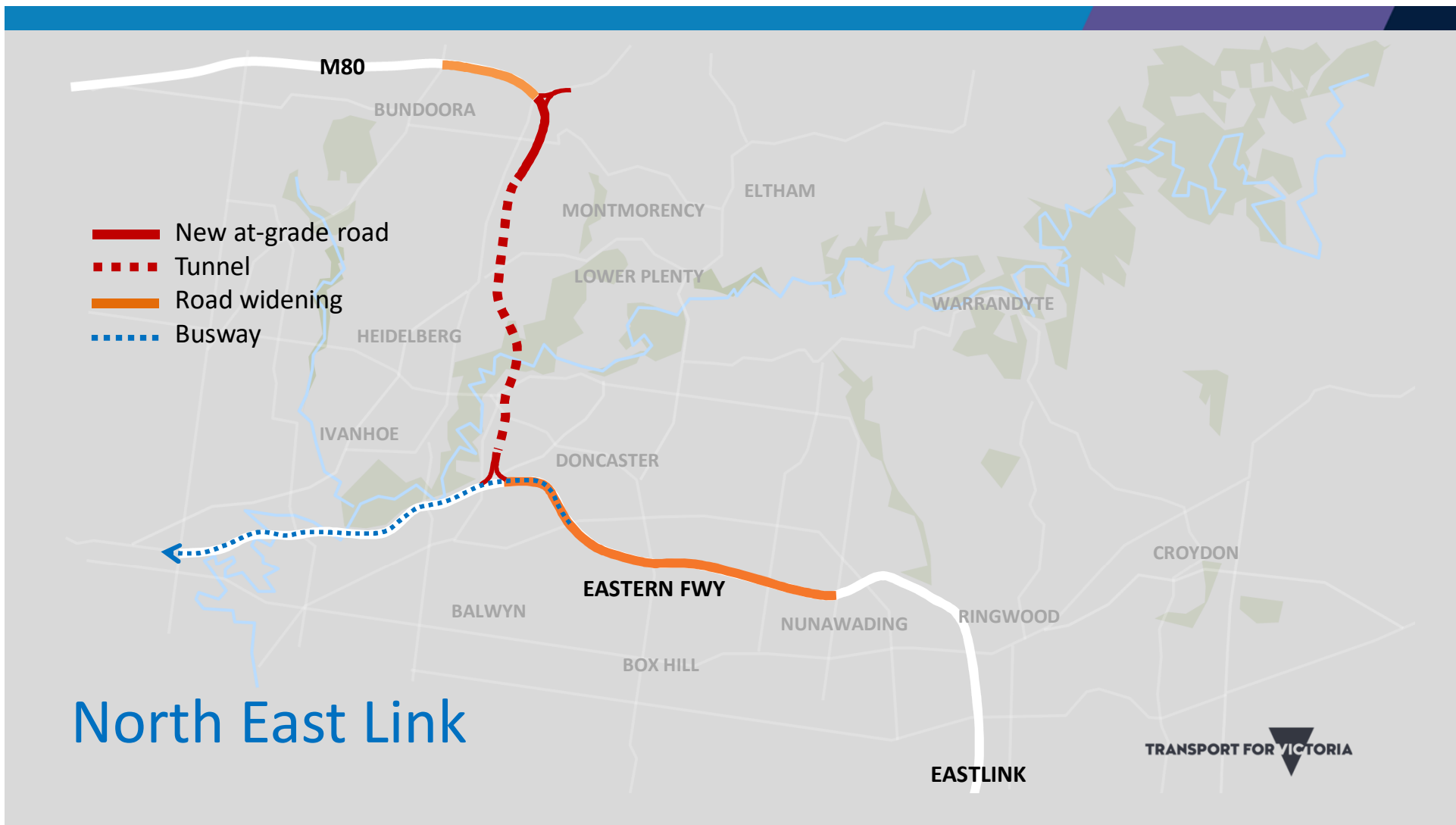

FIXING REGIONAL ROADS

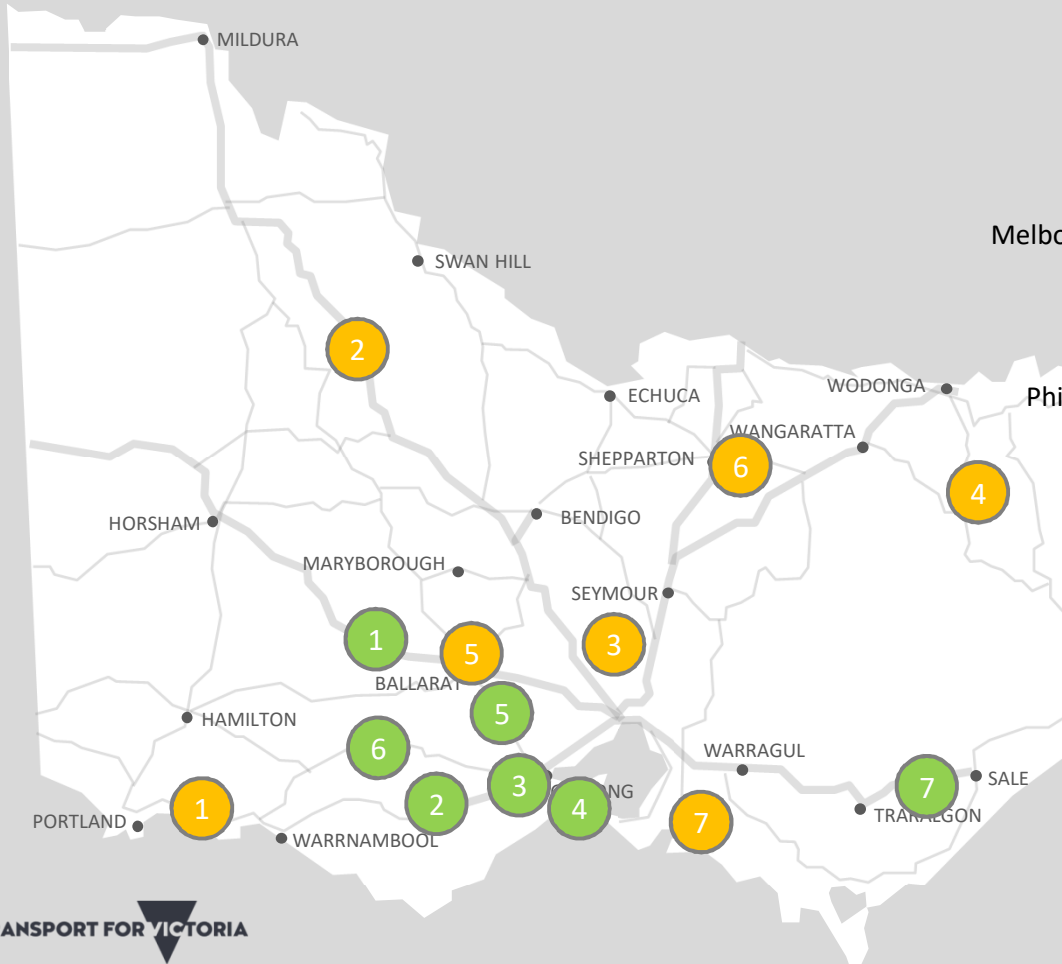
\$941 million for regional roads

- \$433 million for regional road resurfacing and rehabilitation
- \$229 million for safety upgrades to our regional road network

Key regional road upgrades:

- \$49 million for the Beaufort bypass
- \$49 million for the Ararat bypass
- \$40 million for Princes Highway West upgrades – Colac to SA border
- \$20 million for Shepparton heavy vehicle alternative freight route upgrade
- \$19 million for Calder Highway upgrade

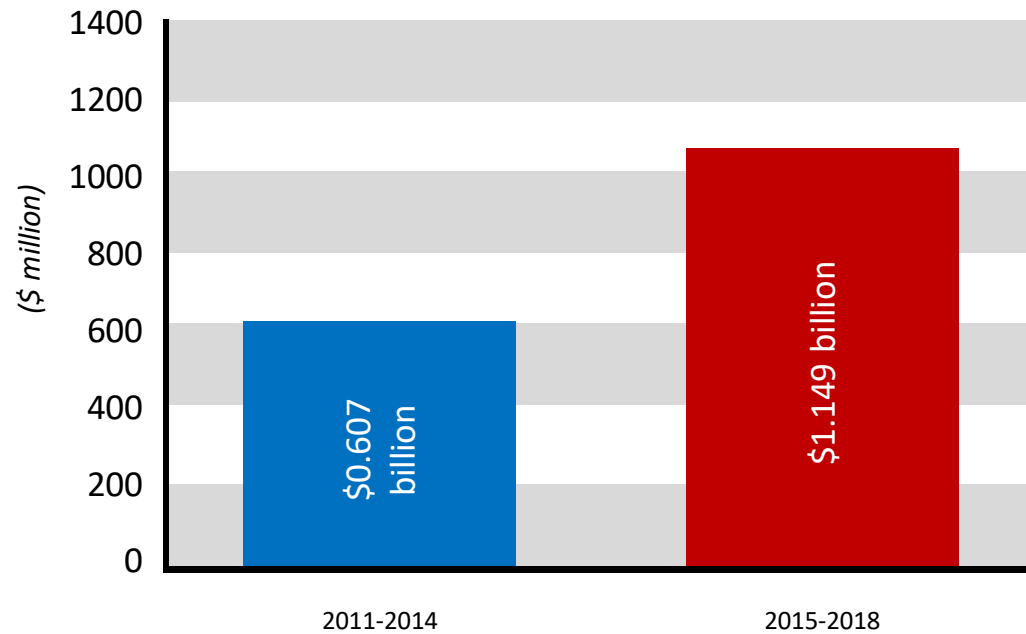

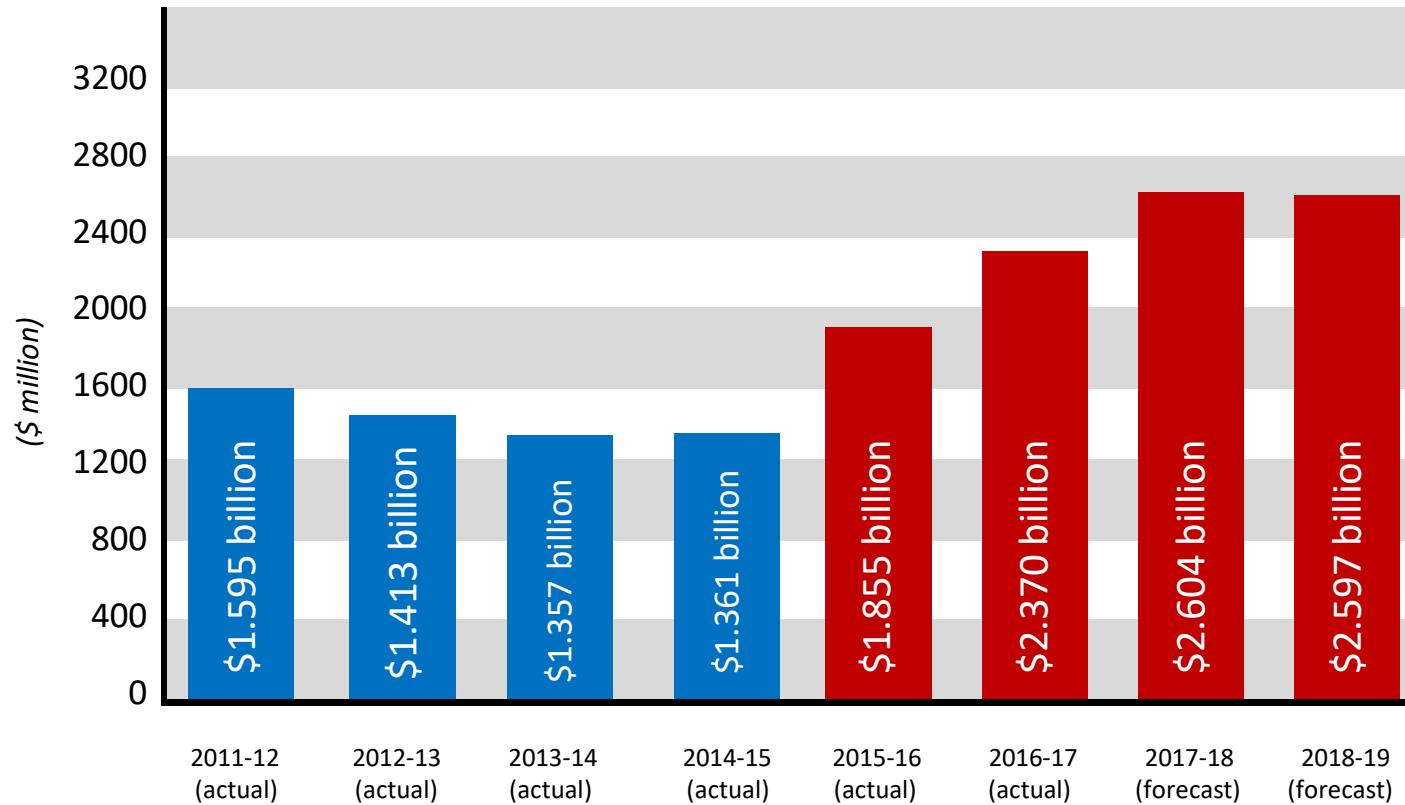
Total maintenance expenditure
