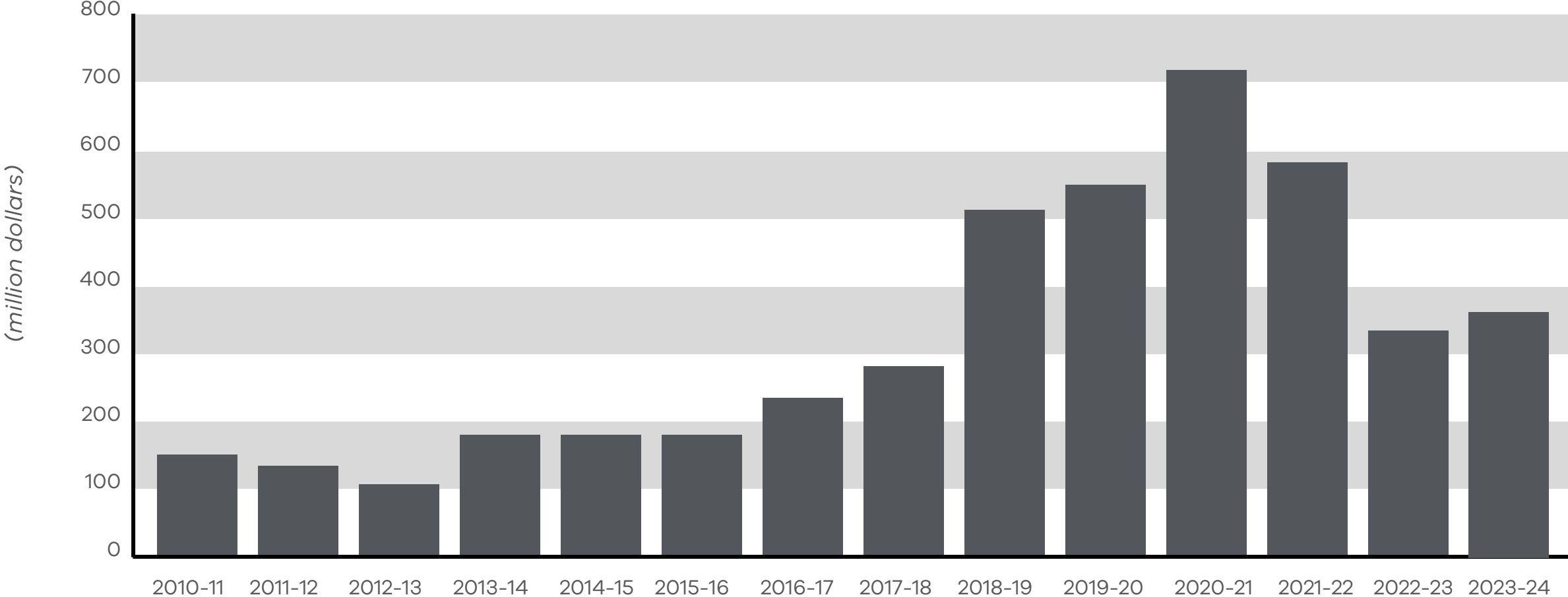

Key planning and heritage initiatives

2023-24 Victorian Budget



\$3.7 million
to give consumers better protection and choice when building and renovating



\$3.8 million
to champion Victoria's outstanding heritage



\$23.4 million
to deliver the investment, infrastructure and services Victorians need



\$9.1 million
for Plan Melbourne implementation



\$3.5 million
to unlock new communities and affordable housing

Plan Melbourne refresh



- Since 2014, just 56 per cent of new housing has occurred in established areas.
- Plan Melbourne is ready for a refresh.
- The revised Plan Melbourne will focus more sharply on increasing housing supply in established urban areas.
- It will also increase the variety of housing types and introduce new market-delivery models.

- Development Facilitation Program has unlocked \$5.7 billion in private sector investment and slashed approval timeframes
- Successful implementation of the Regional Planning Hub
- Better Planning Approvals Program
