

In response to the questions on notice

At the hearing, the following matters were taken on notice:

1. Of the 241 000 hectares allocated to VicForests, what is the total area of ash forest?

The Allocation (Amendment) Order 2014 allocated 1,820,000 ha to VicForests, of which 241,000 ha was Ash forest.

Ash forest was defined as areas dominated by *E. delegatensis*, *E. regnans* or *E. nitens*

2. Can you explain C-grade logs, surplus to domestic requirements, being sold at Big Traffic export?

This question from Ms Dunn related to photograph which has not been provided to VicForests, therefore we are unable to provide any commentary in regards to what they show.

I note on page 41 Mr Trushell says " I will take on notice the allegations around C-grade logs. That has not been provided to me"

In response Ms Dunn says " Yes, and I am happy to provide you with that photo"

3. What is the volume of E-grade logs?

The volume of E-grade logs sold to to Big Traffic or Orient Exports during 2016/17 was approximately 46,800 m³

4. How many hectares are there of loggable public land in Victoria?

The Allocation (Amendment) Order 2014 stated that 1,820,000 ha of State forest is available for harvest.

Of this allocated area VicForests' modelling predicts that approximately 800,000 is currently either suitable or potentially suitable for harvesting.
