Hearings to commence on electric vehicles

The parliamentary inquiry into electric vehicles will commence public hearings on 8 and 9 November.

The Economy and Infrastructure Committee is examining the benefits, manufacturing and applicability of electric vehicles in Victoria.

The first hearings, which are open to the public, will be held in the Legislative Council Committee Room at Parliament House, followed by a further hearing on 21 November.

Submissions for the inquiry are being accepted until 11 December 2017.

The Committee's inquiry will help to identify some of the environmental, regulatory, infrastructure and employment options that can be considered in relation to electric vehicles.
