The Victorian Parliament's Economy and Infrastructure Committee will hold a public hearing on Tuesday 1 September for its inquiry into infrastructure projects.

The hearing with the CEO of the Level Crossing Removal Authority, Kevin Devlin, will be from 12:15 pm to 1:15 pm in Room G6, 55 St Andrew's Place, East Melbourne.

Under its terms of reference, the Committee will consider and report, at least once every six months, on public sector infrastructure and public works projects, including current and past infrastructure projects and proposals.
