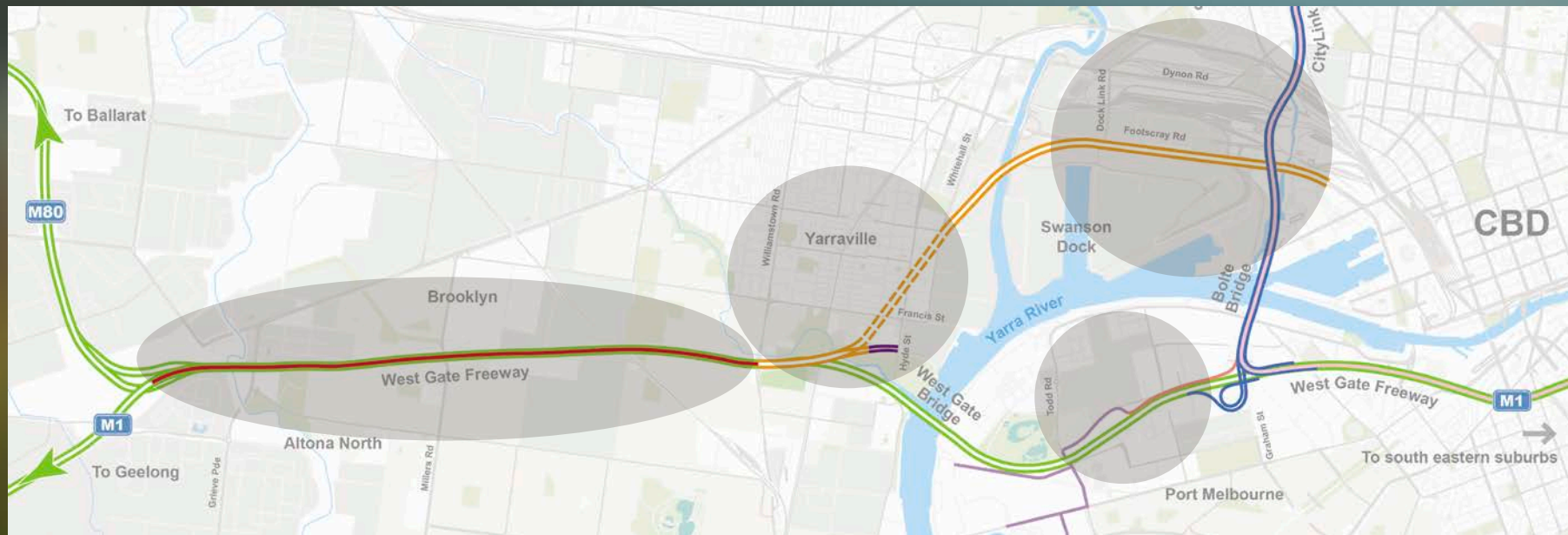


Trucks impacting community liveability now
