Education focus for autism services hearing

The Autism Teaching Institute and Baltara Special School will be presenting to the next public hearing on autism services this Monday 21 November.

The public hearing will be held from 9:30 am to 3:45 pm in Meeting Room G7 at 55 St Andrews Place, East Melbourne.

The Family and Community Development Committee will also hear from service providers and people living with Autism Spectrum Disorder.

The Committee is looking into the availability and adequacy of services for people with Autism Spectrum Disorder, including services provided by the Commonwealth, State and local governments across health, education, disability, housing, sport and employment.
