
EPA's role in fire emergencies

Air Monitoring Capability



General conditions (ambient)

- The "big picture" information on general (ambient) air quality and pollution
- Four Fixed Air Monitoring Stations (Traralgon, Alphington, Footscray and Geelong)





Local conditions

- Fifteen community locations with specific pollution concern. (e.g. Brooklyn, Morewell, Moe, Churchill, Altona, Dandenong)
- Stations can be moved to different locations based on local pollution for set periods



Incident Air Monitoring

- Immediate indicative data about the health impacts of a pollution event
- Deployed rapidly to major and specific pollution events


Data collection and analysis done by community. Can include sampling air with a portable sampler








