- Clearway management reforms






Great Ocean Road upgrade

Road safety initiatives

- New and enhanced pedestrian crossings
- Temporary walking and cycling infrastructure
- The one-metre rule for cyclists
- School crossing supervisors
- Work underway on a new road safety strategy



Registration and licensing recovery

- Funding for a temporary expansion of testing and assessment services to reduce the waiting time for registration and licensing services.
- Waiving appointment fees for all learner permit, hazard perception and driving test customers affected by the suspension of appointments and longer wait times.
- Traffic management support to reduce the cost of organising public events across Victoria
