State education inquiry hearings this week

The parliamentary inquiry into the state education system will hold a further two days of public hearings in Melbourne this week.

You can <u>watch the live broadcast</u> of the Legislative Council Legal and Social Issues Committee from 9 am on both Wednesday 8 and Thursday 9 May.

The full witness schedules have been published online and include representatives from the Australian Education Union, Centre for Adolescent Health and Brotherhood of St Laurence.

The Victorian Student Representative Council, Youth Affairs Council Victoria, Teach for Australia, Centre for Multicultural Youth and the Department of Education are also set to appear.

"This will be an important couple of days for our inquiry, as we hear from a wide range of witnesses on key matters relating to our state education system," Committee Chair Trung Luu said.

"I encourage anyone with an interest in this significant subject to watch our live broadcast."

The Committee travelled throughout regional Victoria in March and April, holding hearings at Bairnsdale, Traralgon, Bendigo and Shepparton.

The inquiry report is due to be tabled in parliament by 15 October 2024.
