

Filters (cont)

You can filter by:

- Parliament
- House
- Question type
- Status answered/unanswered
- Asked by who asked the question
- Portfolio which question (or member) the question is addressed to
- Date asked
- Date answered

Showing options (and minimising)

Use the arrows to see the options for each filter and then minimise the filter so you can see the other filters/the results.




Current and former portfolios

In the portfolios filter, current portfolios are listed at the top and former portfolios are listed underneath.

There is a scroll bar at the side of the list so you can scroll through to find the portfolio you need.

Members who have been asked questions are listed at the very bottom.




Filters (cont)

Asked and Answered filters

When you select the 'Specify a date range' option, you need to click the first date of the range and then the last date.

If you want to search just one day, click that date twice.

In this example, the date range 14 to 31 March has been selected. Other days (7, 8, 9, 21, 22, 23 March) are circled to show you there are questions for those dates.



Parliament (Session) filter

The database filters by the current (60th) parliament's questions by default.

This filter is locked, so you can't accidently <u>clear</u> it by mistake.

The database does include questions from the 59th Parliament. To see and search those, select the 59th Parliament in the Session filter.




TIP: Remember to untick the 59th Parliament when you have finished, so that you don't accidently include old results in your next search.

House indicators

On the list of questions, coloured symbols show which House the question was asked in.



Clearing your search

There are several different ways to clear your searches.

Clear Term

'Clear Term' clears your number or word search only



Clear filters

'Clear filters' clears the filters only.




Note: 'Clear filters' does not clear the <u>session filter</u> if the lock on that filter is closed. (This stops you accidentally searching older questions.)



Clearing your search (cont)

Clear Search

'Clear Search' clears any search terms/numbers AND any filters.



Deleting the refiner buttons

You can clear just part of your search, by deleting one of the refiners



NOTE: This isn't working 100% yet. If you clear multiple refiners this way, you may incorrectly get no search results. If that happens, refresh the page and start again. This will be fixed soon.

Downloading lists and questions

You can download questions and responses in Word and Excel spreadsheets of questions information.

From the list view

Tick the question, or questions, you wish to download and then click the down arrow.



You will get the option to download:

- Word this downloads the question and answer text in Word
- XLSX with Question Text this downloads a list of the question details in Excel. The question text is included.
- XLXS without Question Text this downloads a list of the question details in Excel.



Downloading lists and questions (cont)

TIPS

- Use the down arrow at the top of the list if you have ticked multiple questions to download.
- Tick the box at the top of the list if you want to download all the questions in the list.
