Question Asked:

The CHAIR: Ms Taylor, has Bass Coast done any quantification of the amount of estimated cost of adaptation?

Donna TAYLOR: Council has through each of our five asset management plans applied a climate lens. What that lens looks like is different by asset class. I would be happy to supply that information to the committee. **The CHAIR**: That would be good if you could provide that information on notice. That will be very helpful.

Response:

The current annual allocation in Council's Long Term Financial Plan for renewal in 2025/26 is \$13.076,800. Through development of our asset management plans Council have identified that an additional \$1,640,100 would be required to respond to climate risks within each asset class. These additional costs are a combination of additional modelling work related to drainage, changes to materials types and construction methods.
