Select Committee on the 2026 Commonwealth Games Bid

Games probe accepting further submissions

The Upper House inquiry into the 2026 Commonwealth Games Bid has reopened to submissions from the public.

Victorians can <u>have their say via the online form</u> until Monday 4 November 2024.

The Legislative Council Select Committee is seeking information about the progress of the \$4 billion funding package for regional Victoria, which was announced instead of holding the event.

"In addition to investigating the events leading to the cancellation of the Games, the terms of reference for our inquiry include considering the timeline, progress and budget of the Government's infrastructure and housing build," Committee Chair David Limbrick said.

"We're inviting further submissions and evidence from people about the allocation of funding to the progress of various projects around the state."

The Committee received 33 submissions in the initial phase of public input in 2023. There have been 10 days of public hearings, and two interim reports tabled since.
