Question: In Victoria how many of those recommendations that pertain to people in police custody, rather than people in custody of corrections, are acquitted, how many are partially acquitted and how many remain outstanding?

Reply:

The Victorian Aboriginal Justice Caucus is conducting an Aboriginal-led independent review of Victoria's progress in implementing the 339 recommendations made by the Royal Commission into Aboriginal Deaths in Custody in 1991.

The Victorian Government has provided \$1.92 million to fund this independent review. The final report is to be completed next year.

In the interest of not pre-empting the findings of the independent Aboriginal-led review, the Department of Justice and Community Safety has not provided a self-assessment of progress towards implementation of the Royal Commission into Aboriginal Deaths in Custody recommendations.
