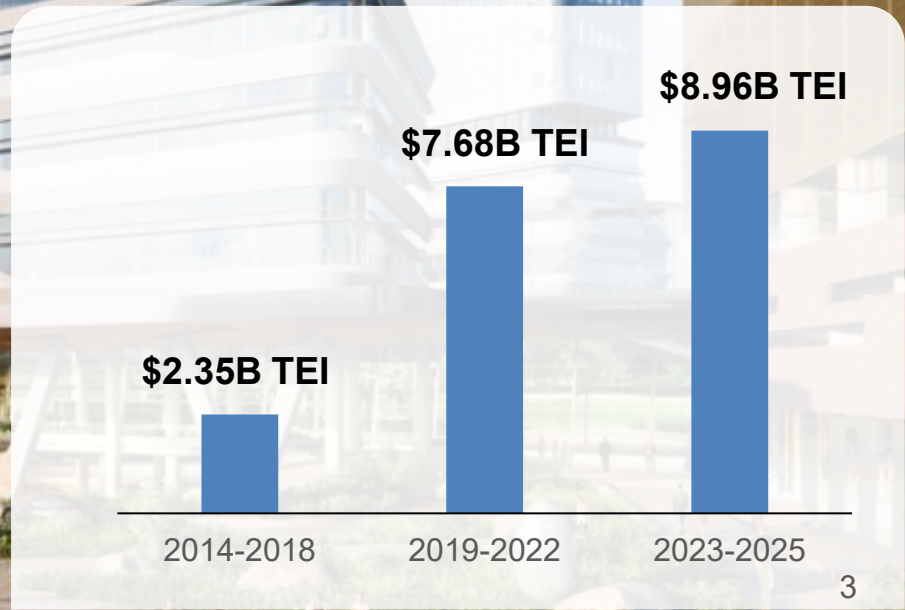

Decade of growth in health infrastructure investment



Northern Hospital development project

The \$812.5 million investment for the Northern Hospital will add a new emergency department and inpatient tower which will include an alcohol and other drugs hub, dedicated acute behaviour treatment space, and a dedicated paediatric treatment zone.

The new emergency department will be relocated to Cooper Street and increase the number of treatment spaces for emergency patients to almost 200.





Monash Medical Centre tower expansion project

A \$535 million investment at the Monash Medical Centre will be used to construct a new multi-level tower which will provide a new operating theatre complex, a new intensive care unit, and a new and expanded birthing unit and maternity inpatient beds.



Austin Hospital emergency department expansion project

A \$275 million investment at the Austin Hospital will add up to 29 extra emergency treatment spaces, an upgraded short stay unit, and improved clinical administration spaces.

The upgrade will support up to an extra 30,000 emergency patients every year, ensuring the hospital can meet the needs of the growing local population.

State-wide grants to support local health services

More than \$85 million investment to support Victoria's health services through infrastructure and capital grant programs:

- \$40 million for the Engineering Infrastructure Replacement Fund
- \$35 million for the Medical Equipment Replacement Fund
- \$10 million for the Mental Health Capital Renewal Fund
- And of course, our investment in our signature Regional Health Infrastructure Fund continues.
