**Reply:**

The Department of Justice and Community Safety (DJCS) provides breakdowns of staffing numbers – including Youth Justice Workers – in its Annual Reports, and also in the DJCS PAEC questionnaire. The breakdown provided is consistent with longstanding practise.

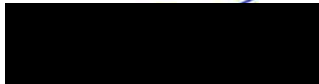

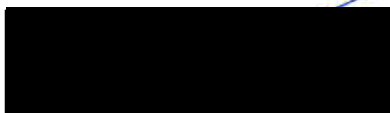
The number of repeat or serious offenders involved in Youth Justice is the subject of regular public reporting, including by the Australian Institute of Health and Welfare (AIHW), as follows:

**Young people with more than 1 supervised sentence for all possible Youth Justice supervision, 2000-01 - 2021-22 in Victoria (table s7 AIHW Youth Justice Returns to Supervision 2021-22)**

State	Number of young people who received a sentence	Number of young people with more than 1 sentence	% of young people with more than 1 sentence
Victoria	6,924	2,462	35.56%

- Data relates to young people aged 10–17 who were supervised from 2000–01 to 2021–22.
