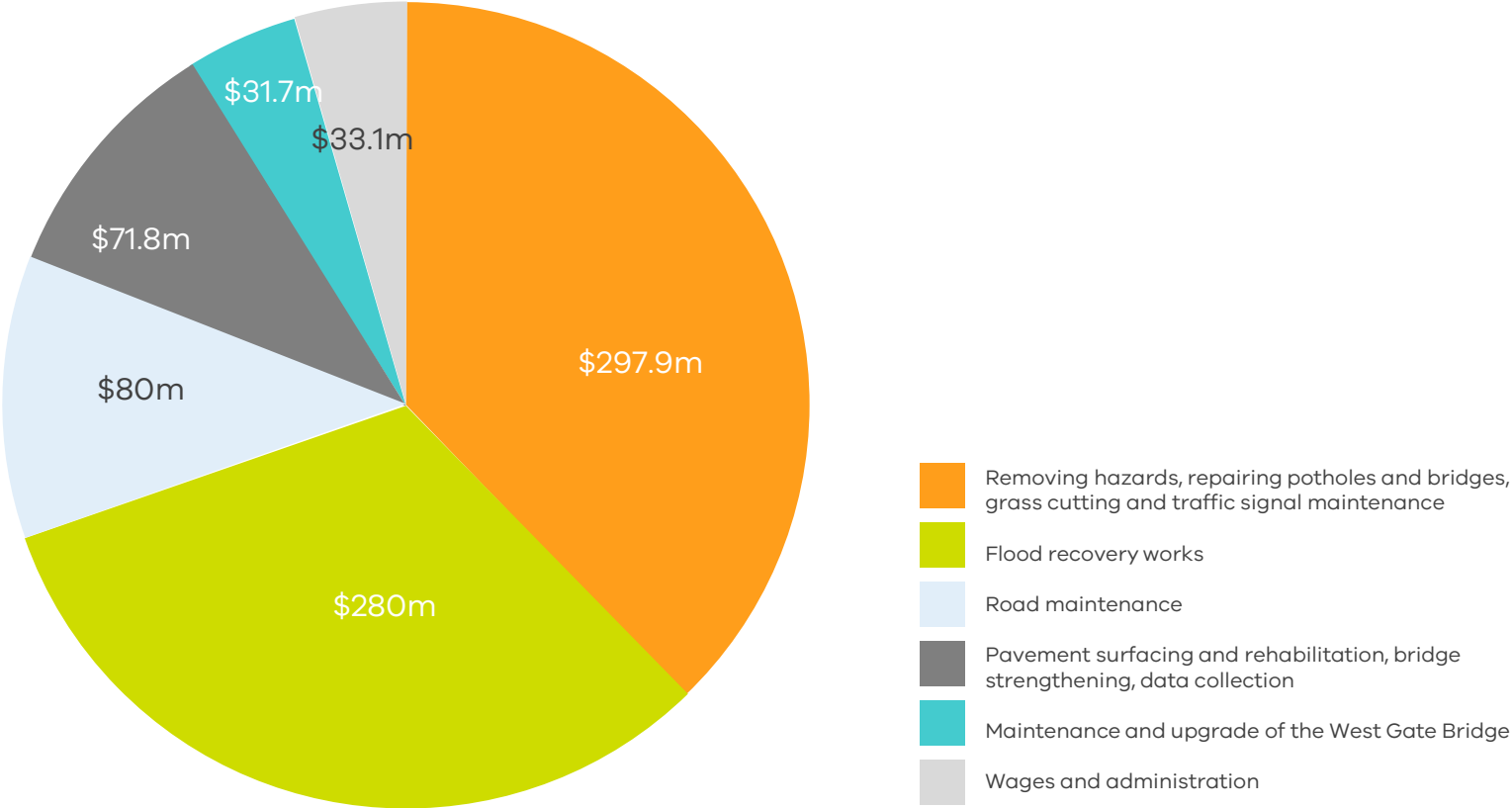

# Road maintenance

- Four separate floods have hit Victoria since Christmas
- \$99 million cash injection to fund large-scale, long-term repairs for some of the most badly-damaged roads.
- Most work centres on the Loddon Mallee and Gippsland regions.

# Road safety

- Road trauma costs over \$6 billion a year or \$17.5 million per day.
- *Victoria's Road Safety Strategy 2021-2030* encompasses education, infrastructure, policy and technology
- There is no single approach to road safety.
