


### **Demand for healthcare is growing fast**

#### **Cumulative population growth by age group,** Victoria, 2011 to 2023




## **Cumulative increase in acute public hospital separations** (excluding same day planned admissions)






### Healthcare needs are increasingly complex

#### Providing care closer to home

**Highest number of planned surgeries delivered** in 2023-24 (209,925) - 10% higher than last year

Almost 20% reduction in waitlist since June 2023 and 5% increase in patients treated within clinically recommended time

A more **resilient and capable** planned surgery system following the release and implementation of the Planned Surgery Reform Blueprint 420,000 days of hospital care in a patient's own home through the **Better at Home initiative** 360,000 presentations to **Priority Primary Care Centres** Launch of our mobile **women's health clinic** in partnership with BreastScreen Victoria
