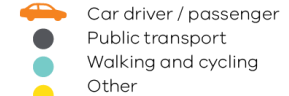

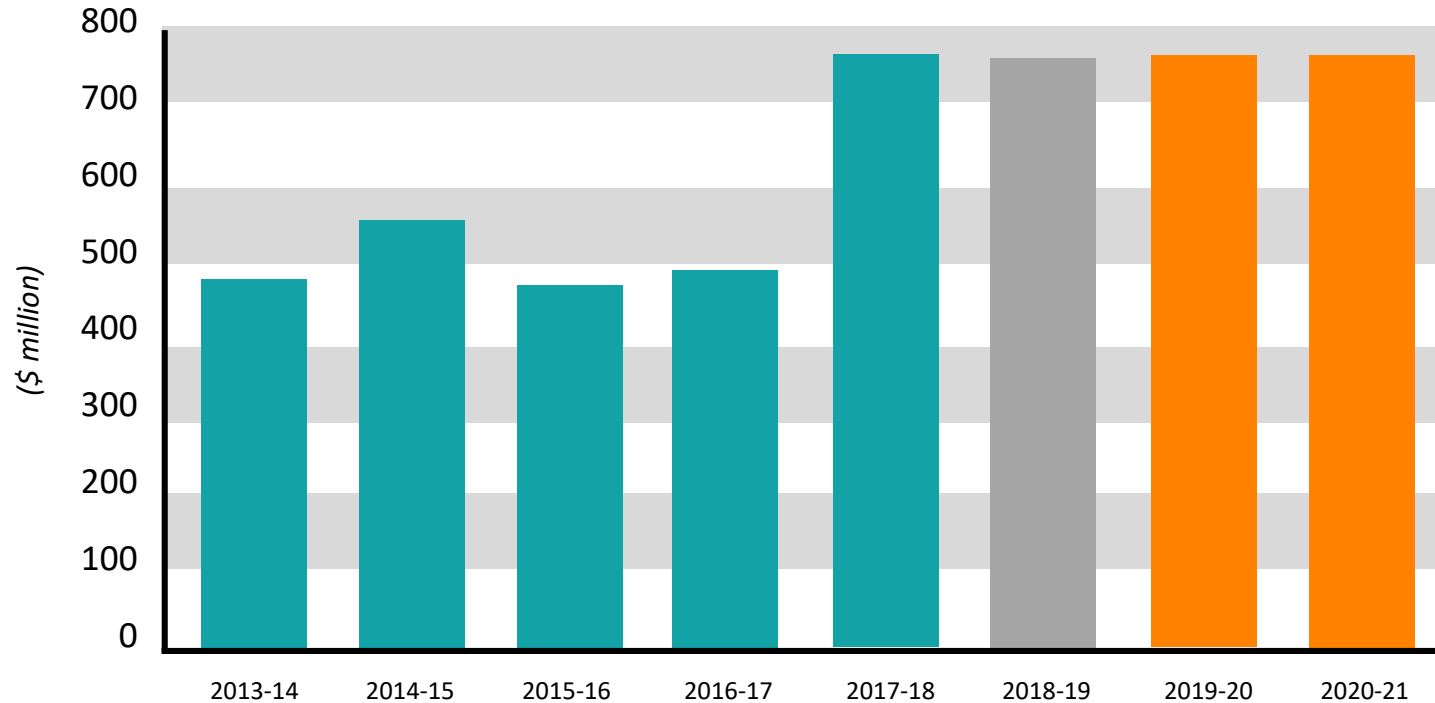
Key Budget initiatives

- \$653 million over two years for pavement rehabilitation and works to prevent road deterioration
- \$52.9 million to fix some of our busiest and most congested local intersections
- \$60.8 million to Keep Ballarat Moving
- \$45.4 million in new bike and pedestrian paths
- \$19.3 million for school crossing supervisors
- \$121 million for road safety cameras
- \$4 million for Safer Sites, Safer Speeds



Road maintenance

Road operations plus road asset management including pavements, structures, electrical assets, roadside assets and off-network management



Local Cycling and Walking Projects

- The \$100 million Safer Cyclists and Pedestrian Fund is delivering a total of 44 walking and cycling projects across the State.
- Cycling and walking integrated into major project delivery
- New budget initiatives for walking and cycling
- More than **250** kms of new and upgraded cycling paths in delivery
- By the end of 2019, three new cycling corridors will be developed in the south and south east of Melbourne

Towards Zero

Safe Roads

A \$1.4 billion investment in safer roads has resulted in an average 30 per cent reduction in casualty crashes, a 35 per cent reduction of intersection crashes and a 26 per cent reduction in run-off road crashes.

Safe Speeds

Setting appropriate speed limits and educating drivers to travel at speeds that are right for the conditions.

Safe Vehicles

Promoting safety ratings and specific vehicle safety features including a web-based platform that allows consumers to search for star ratings of new and used vehicles

Safe People

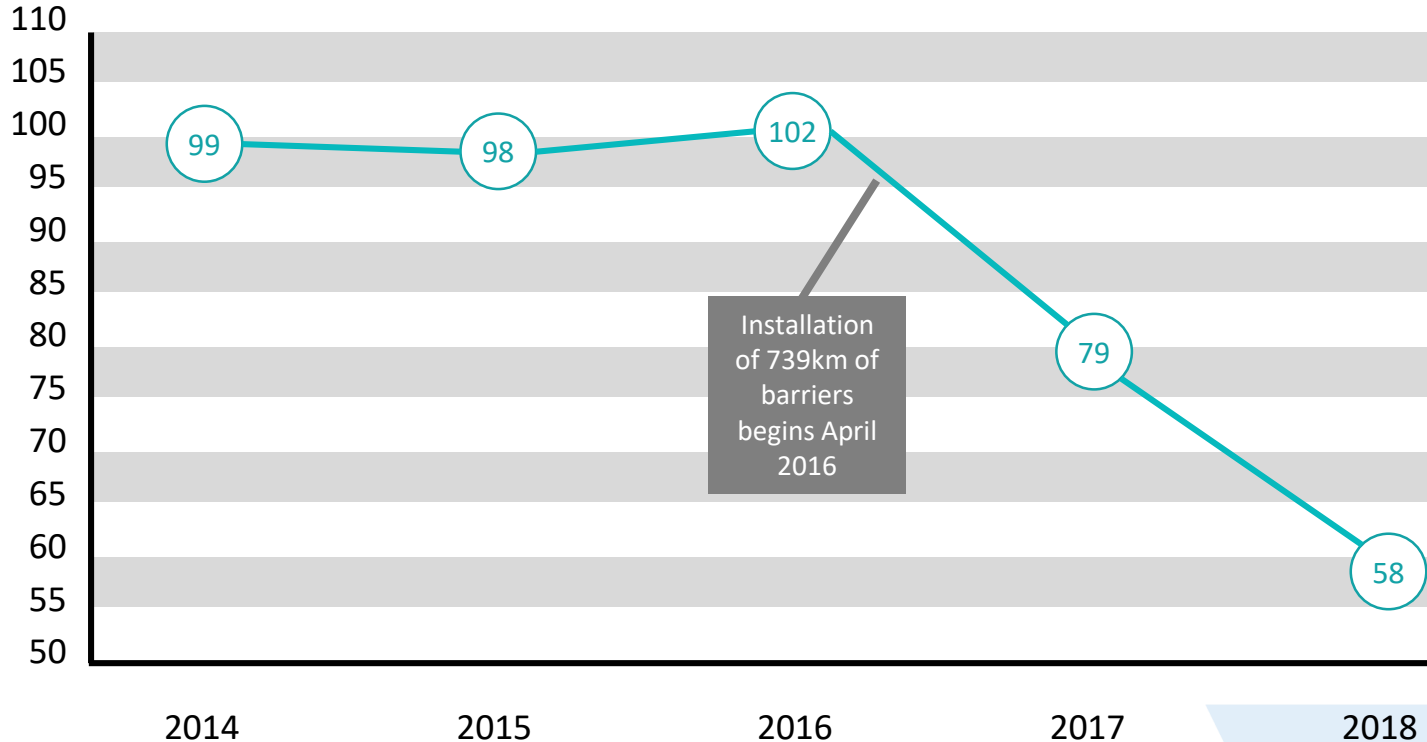
Public education campaigns including:

- People Like Us (targeting phone use)
- Drivers Give the Space to Ride Safe (cycling safety)
- Living Proof (featuring real cases of survivors of accidents)
- Safer Roads Save Lives (showing how safer infrastructure makes our roads safer)
- Think of Us (police enforcement)



Safety barriers reduce the chances of head-on and run-off-road crashes by 85 per cent
