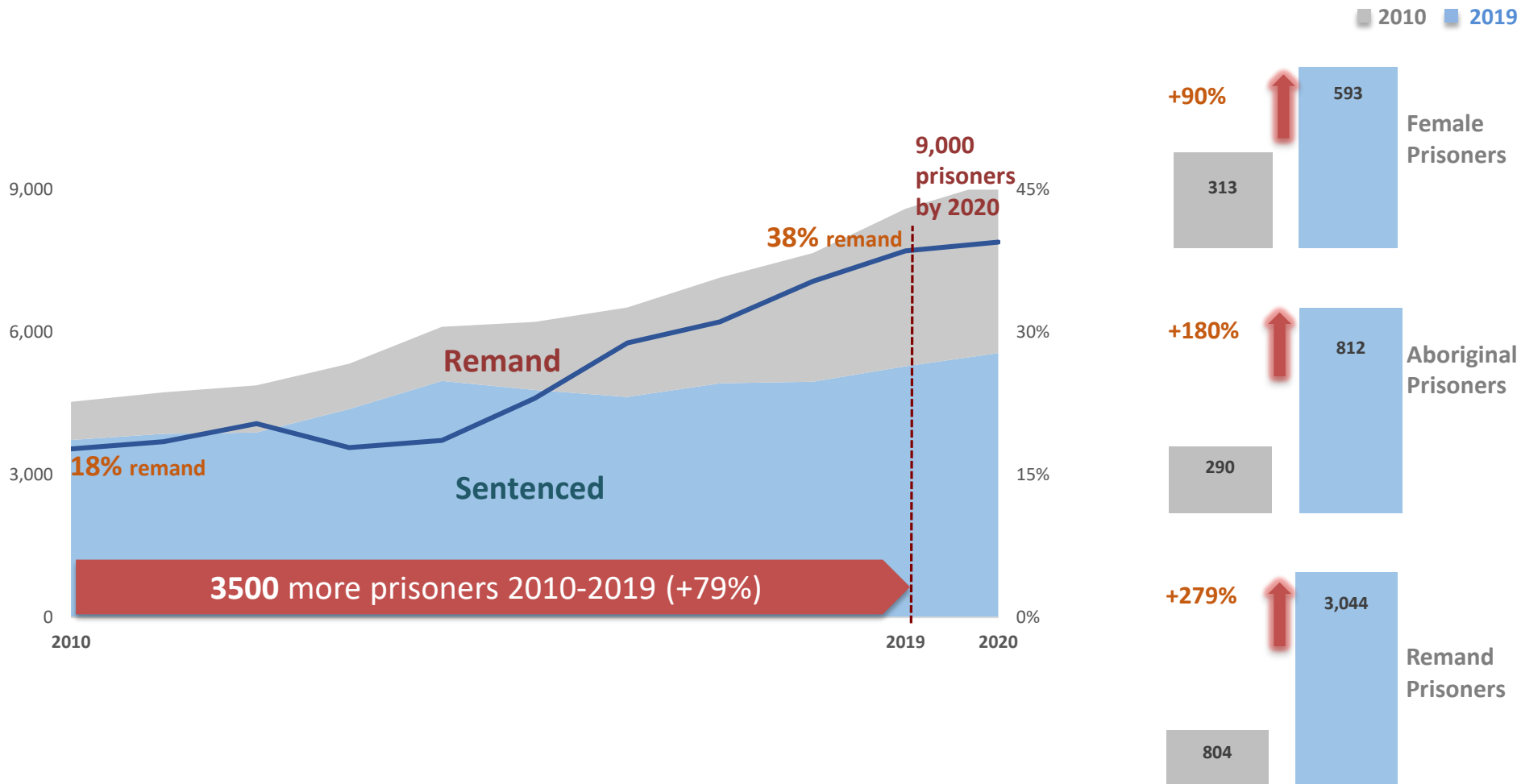

Corrections Budget Overview

- Over \$1.8 billion to expand capacity across men's and women's prison systems
- \$22.7 million for diversion, rehabilitation and reintegration programs
- \$20 million for programs for women prisoners
- Budgeted output funding is **\$1.94 billion in 2019-20**, up from **\$1.03 billion in 2014-15**.

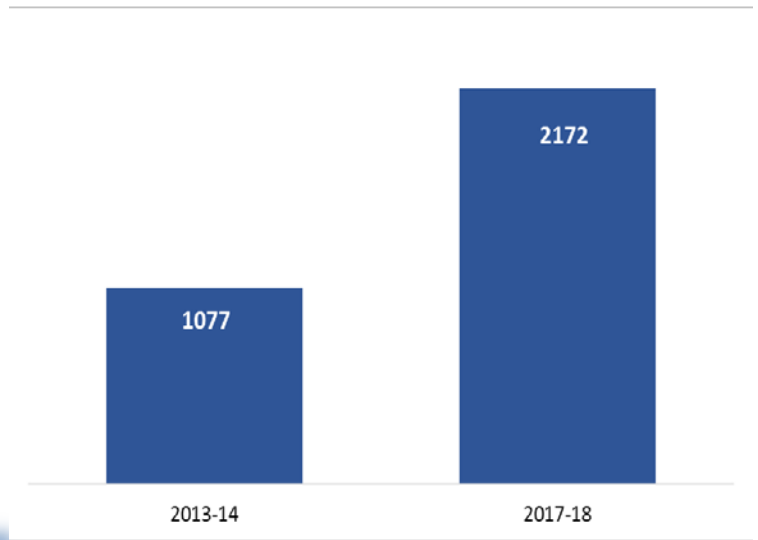

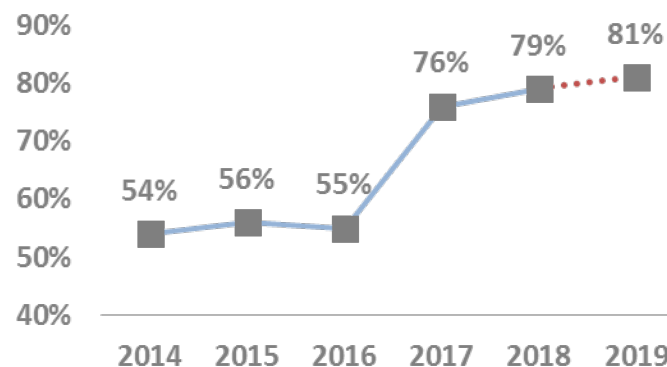

Parole completion rates

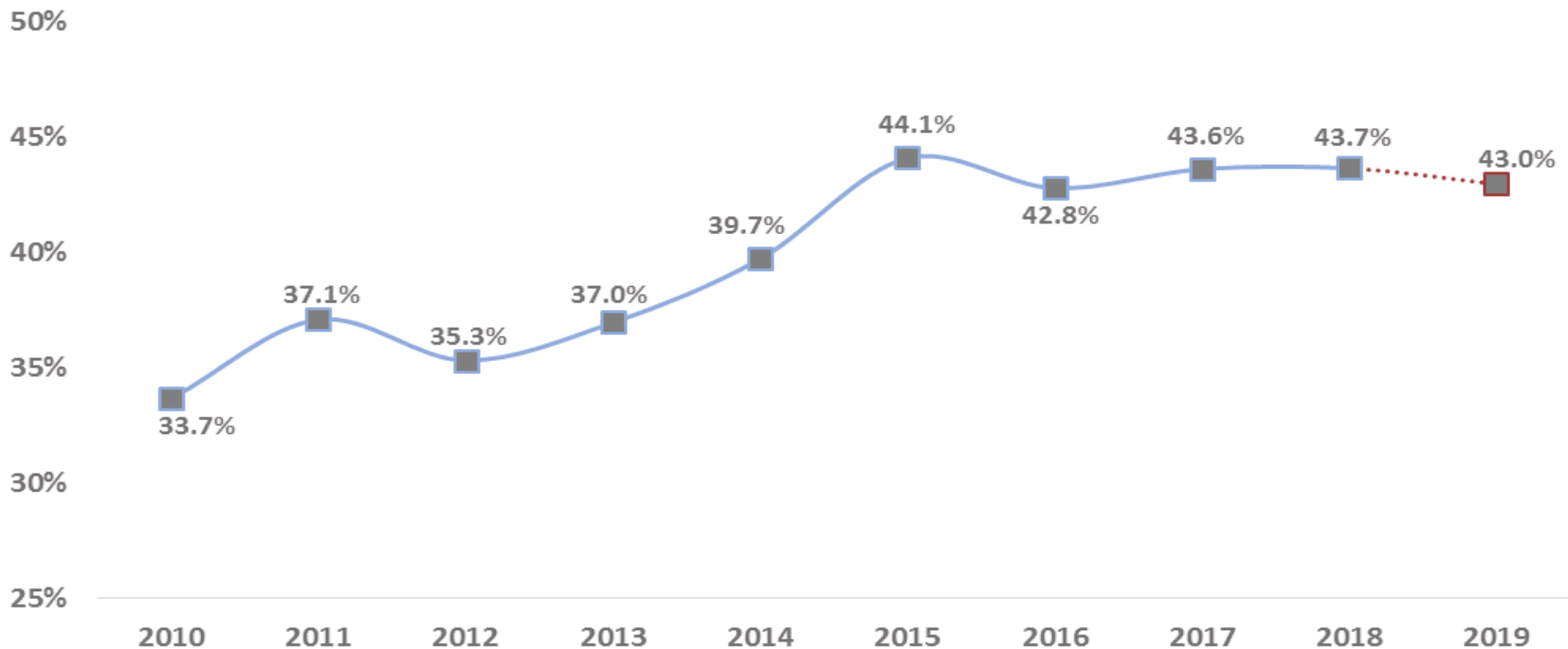
