Key organisations at hearing on environmental water

On Tuesday 5 December the parliamentary inquiry into the management, governance and use of environmental water will hold its next public hearing.

The Environment, Natural Resources and Regional Development Committee will hear from a range of organisations including the Murray-Darling Basin Authority and Victorian government agencies responsible for water management and the environment, as well as the Victorian Farmers Federation and representatives of the Wentworth Group of Concerned Scientists.

The public hearing will be held from 9:30 am to 3:45 pm at 55 St Andrews Place, East Melbourne. It will also be <u>webcast</u>.

The Committee's inquiry is examining how well water for environmental purposes is being managed in Victoria.
