Regional Committee hearings in Wodonga

Public hearings on two issues of keen interest to regional and rural Victoria will be held in Wodonga next week.

The Environment, Natural Resources and Regional Development Committee will take evidence on its inquiry into the sustainability and operational challenges of Victoria's rural and regional councils, as well as its inquiry into the management, governance and use of environmental water.

The public hearings will be on Tuesday 21 November from 9:30 am to 4:00 pm at the TAFEspace, 158 Lawrence Street, Wodonga.

Local government and ratepayer representatives, researchers, the local catchment management authority and a representative from the Wentworth Group of Concerned Scientists will be among those presenting to the Committee during the two inquiry hearings.
