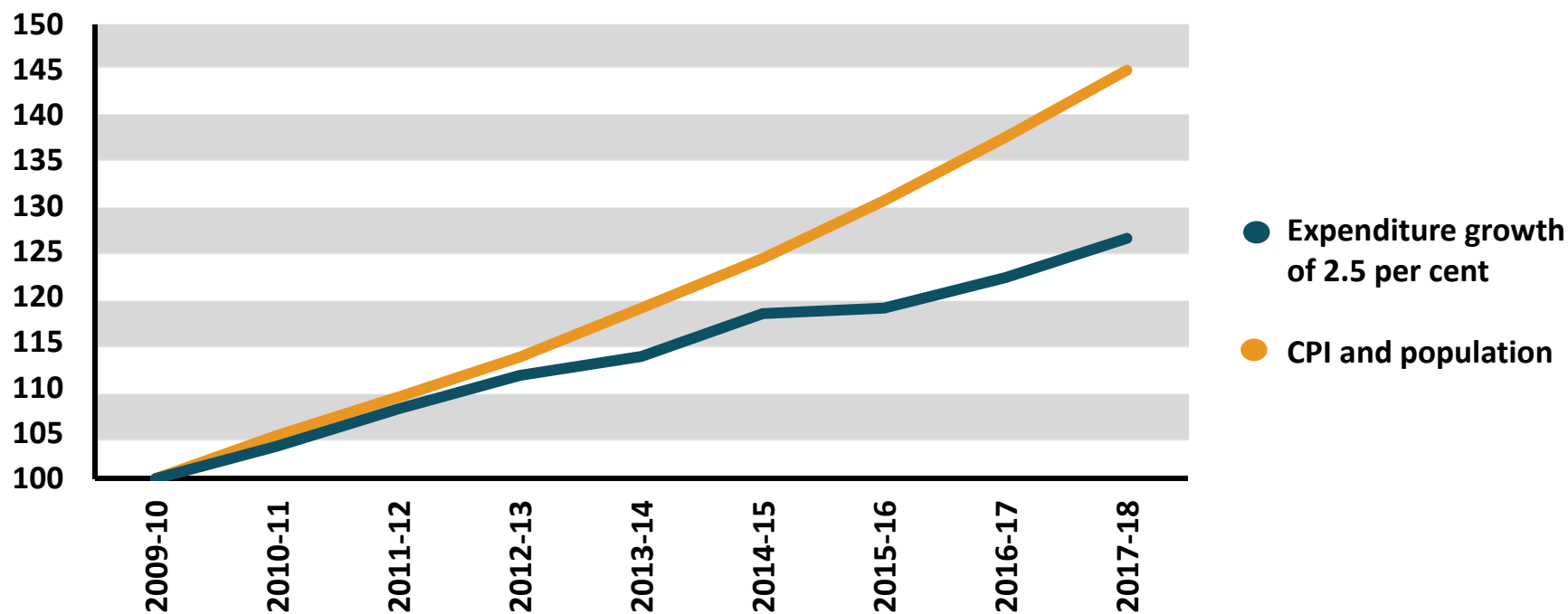

## Operating surplus



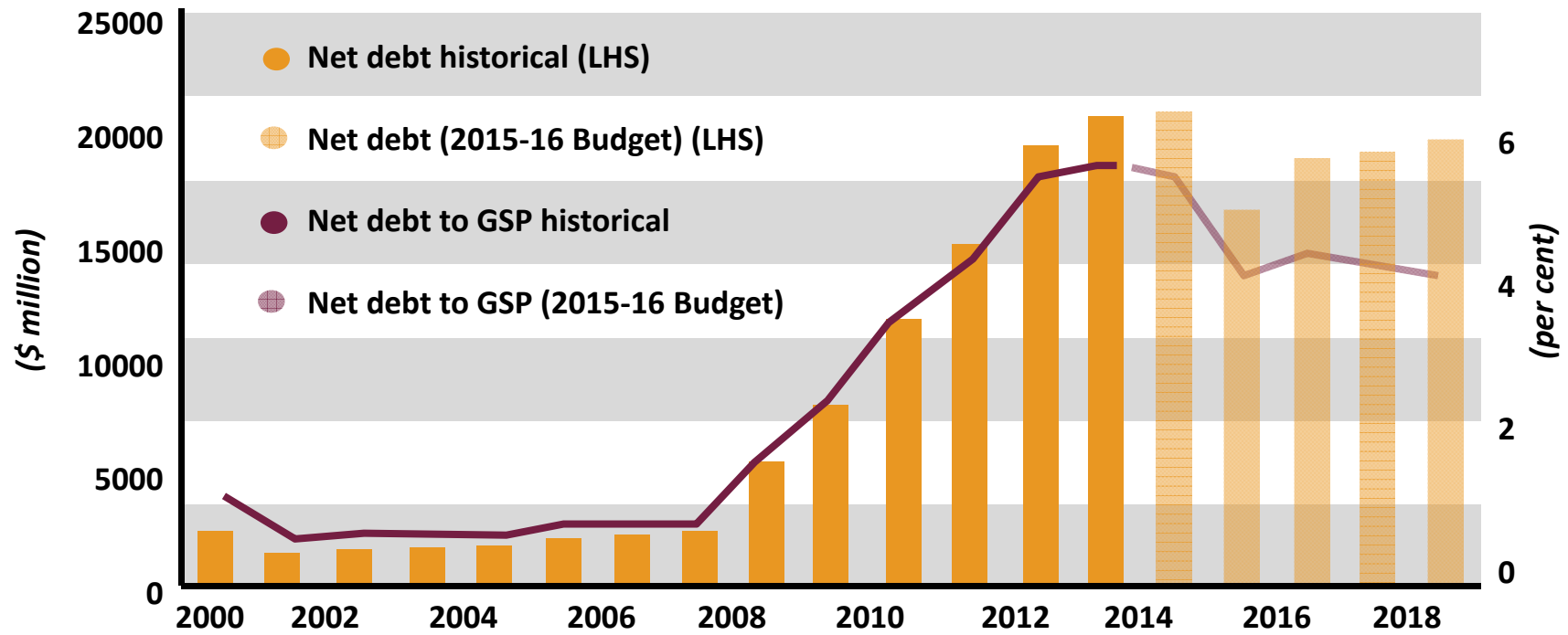

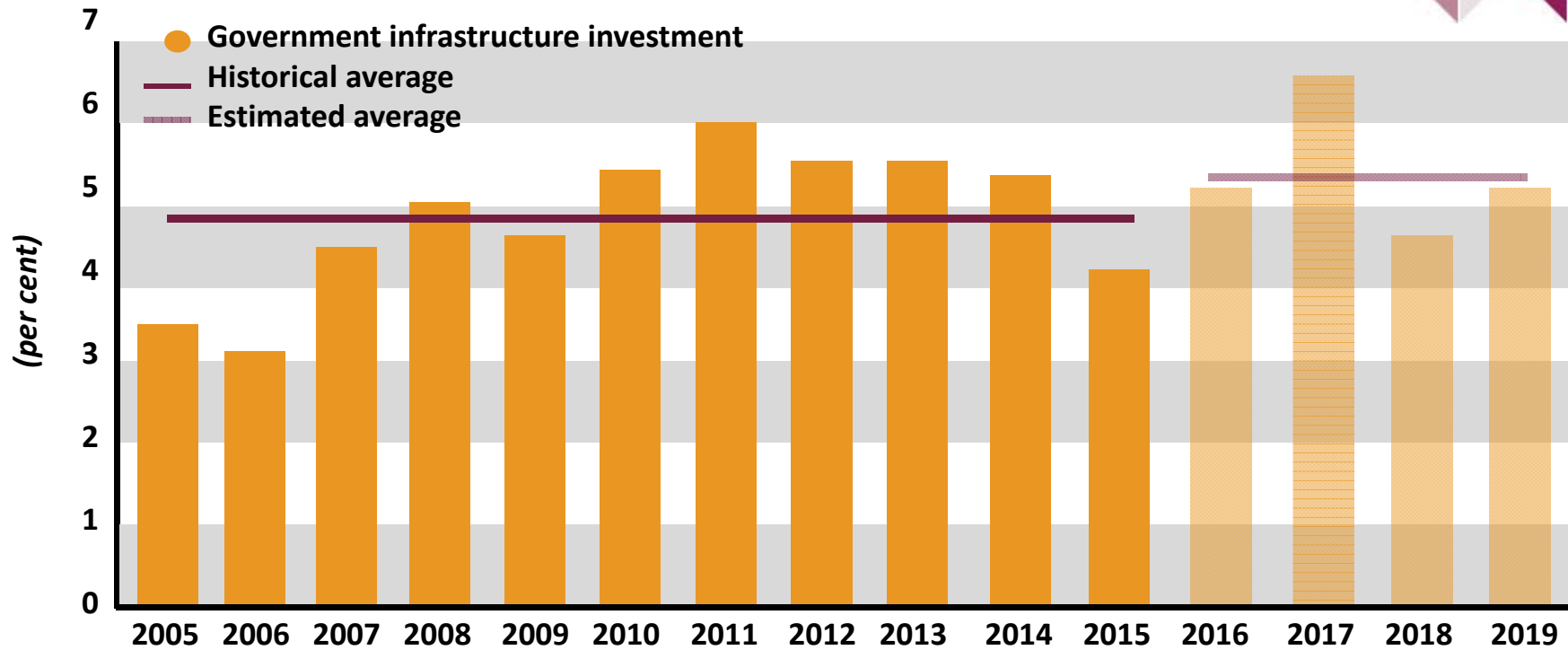
## Net debt



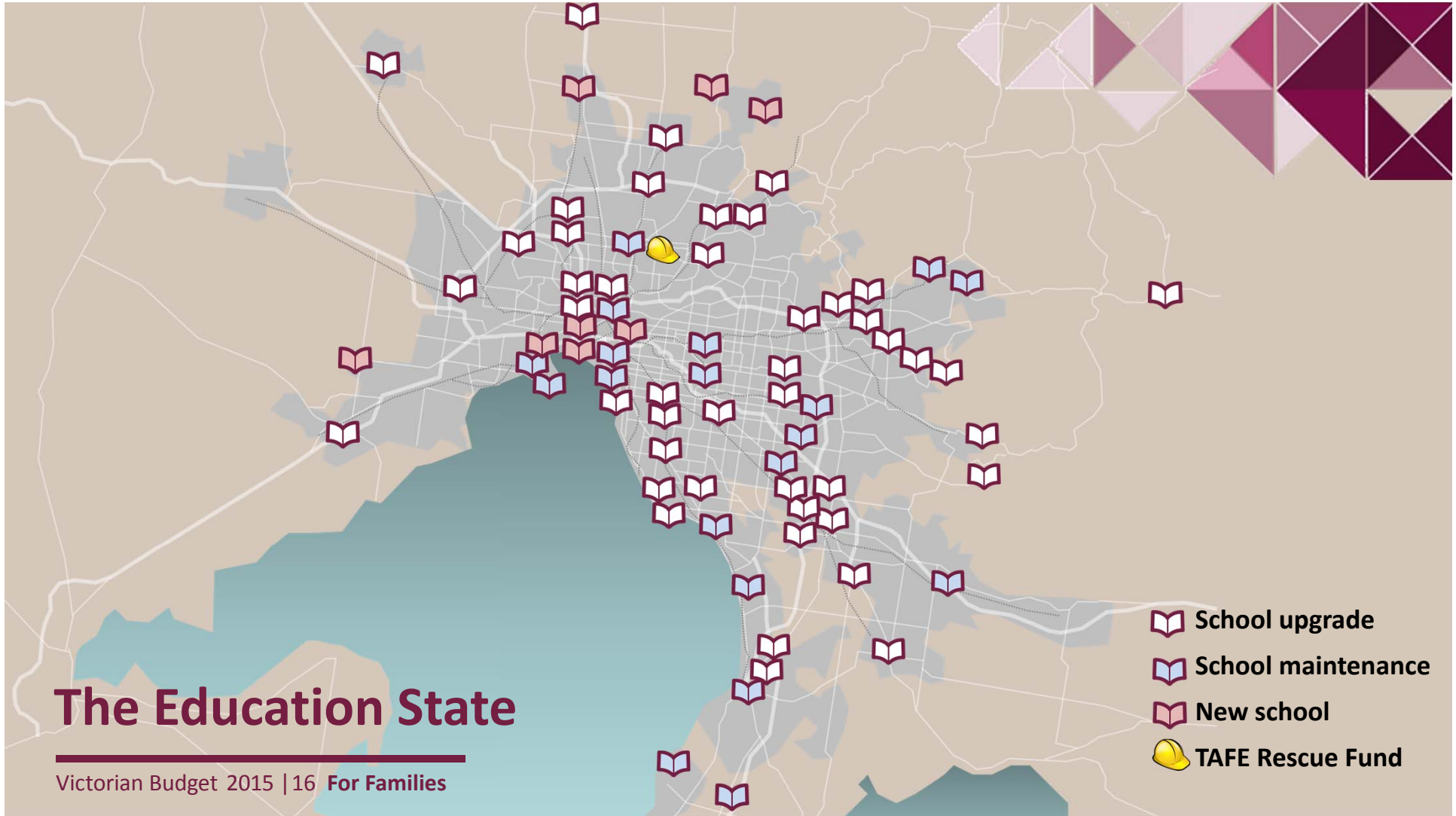
