Hearings and forum in Dunkeld on invasive animals

Public hearings and a public forum will be held in Dunkeld on Tuesday 29 and Wednesday 30 November for the parliamentary inquiry into the control of invasive animals on Crown land.

The hearings and forum will be held at Sterling Place, 14 Sterling Street, Dunkeld.

On Tuesday 29 November, public hearings will take place from 1:30 to 5:00 pm and will be followed by an open forum from 5:00 pm that will provide community members with the opportunity to share their views and experiences with the Environment, Natural Resources and Regional Development Committee.

“The open forum will allow any member of the community to have their say,” said Ms Bronwyn Halfpenny MP, Chair of the Committee. “We are keen to hear from people about what is working and what isn’t in their local areas, and what more can be done to tackle the problems of invasive animals.”

On Wednesday 30 November public hearings will be held from 10:00 am to 1:00 pm.

More than 200 submissions have been received for the inquiry.
