Flood inquiry to hear from Government Ministers

Two Government Ministers are set to appear before the Victorian parliamentary committee investigating the 2022 flood event in Victoria.

Water Minister Harriet Shing and Emergency Services Minister Jaclyn Symes will appear at separate public hearings to be held on Wednesday 6 December.

Wednesday's inquiry hearing will also involve Maribyrnong River Flood Review chair Tony Pagone.

Representatives of global professional services network GHD, and the ARC Centre of Excellence for Climate Extremes at Monash University are due to give evidence in the afternoon.

Jane Nursey, the head of clinical services at Phoenix Australia, a centre for posttraumatic mental health is scheduled to be the final witness of the day.
