Public hearing into new planning Bill

On Friday 10 July, a Victorian parliamentary committee is holding a public hearing in Melbourne in relation to the Planning and Environment Amendment (Recognising Objectors) Bill 2015. The Committee is examining how the proposed change will impact on future planning decisions.

Chair of the Victorian Parliament's Environment and Planning Committee, Hon David Davis, said the Committee would be receiving evidence from key stakeholders.

"This will be a short but thorough inquiry as this legislation is currently before the Parliament," said Mr Davis, "The Committee will report its findings to the Legislative Council on 4 August."
