Key agencies at unconventional gas hearing

The Victorian Government's submission on unconventional gas will be the focus of the next public hearing on Tuesday 18 August for the parliamentary inquiry by the Environment and Planning Committee.

The Government has now also released its water science studies for the Otway and Gippsland basins and these form an important part of the evidence available to the Committee.

The Department of Economic Development, Jobs, Transport and Resources and the Department of Environment, Land, Water and Planning will answer questions at the hearing.

It is being held from 12 noon to 1:20 pm in the Legislative Council Committee Room at Parliament House, Melbourne.
