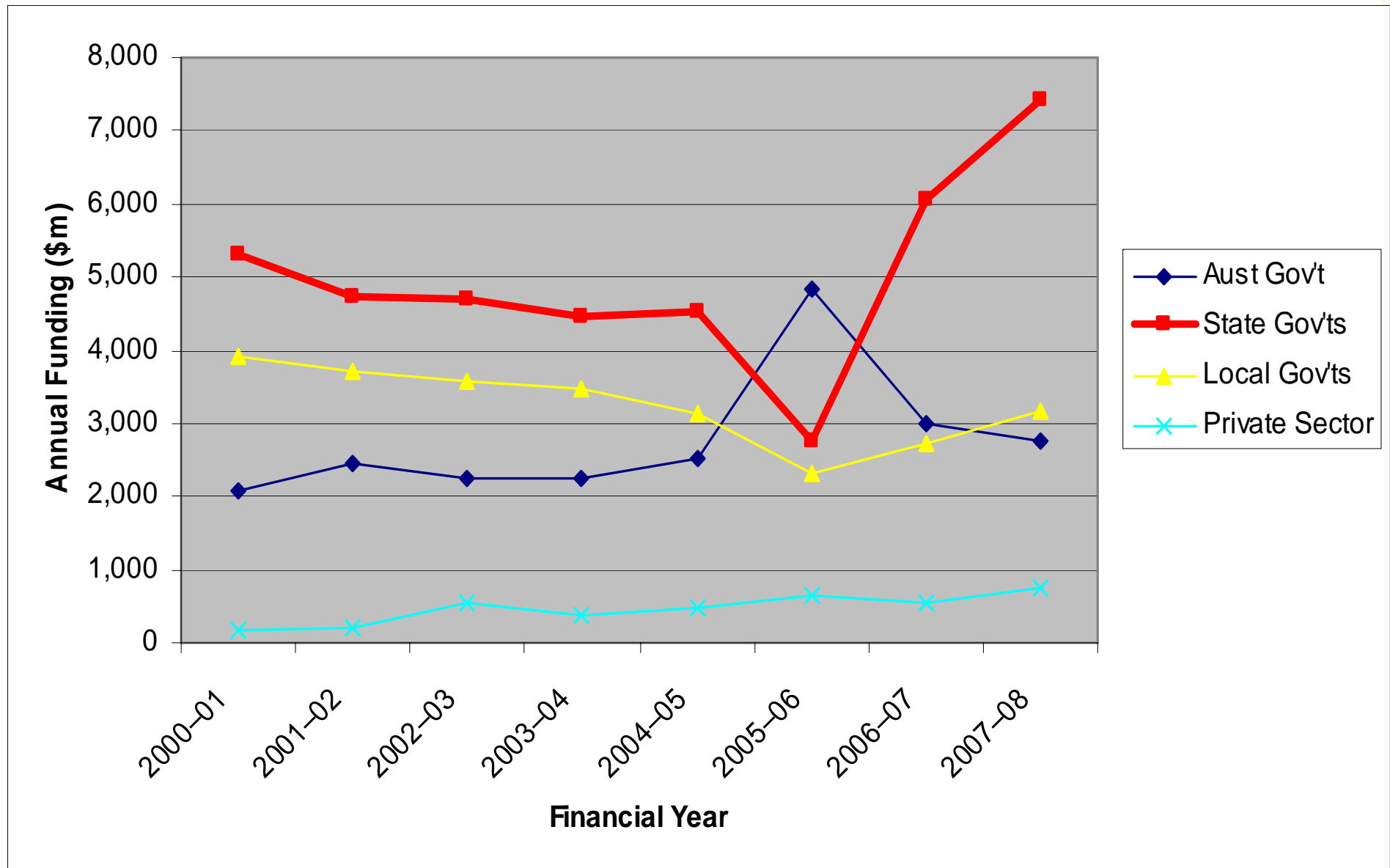
## Responsibilities by Level of Government

- The Australian Government is primarily responsible for a defined set of National Roads
- The State Governments are primarily responsible for other declared arterial roads
- Local Governments are primarily responsible for local roads but with some financial assistance from the Australian Government

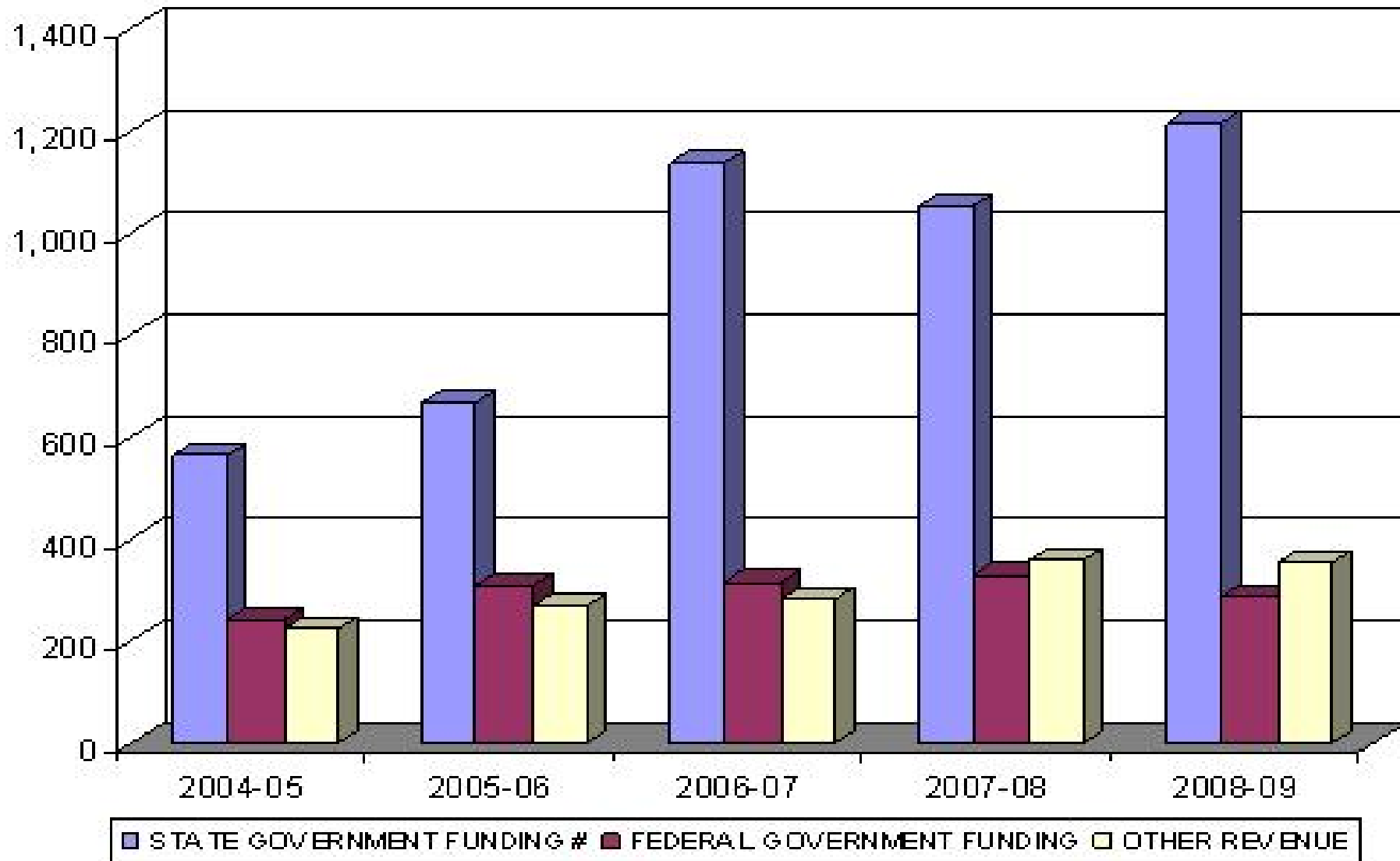
## Responsibilities in Victoria

- VicRoads responsible for:
  - development, maintenance & management arterial road network
  - delivering *arrive alive*, Victoria's Road Safety Strategy in association with a range of partners
  - Roads component of the Federal Nation Building program
- Department of Transport responsible for:
  - efficiency & effectiveness of transport facilities & networks
  - Ensuring an efficient, effective, safe & reliable public transport system
  - Rail component of the Australian Government Nation Building program

# Historical Funding of Road Related Expenditure in Australia (2008-09 prices)

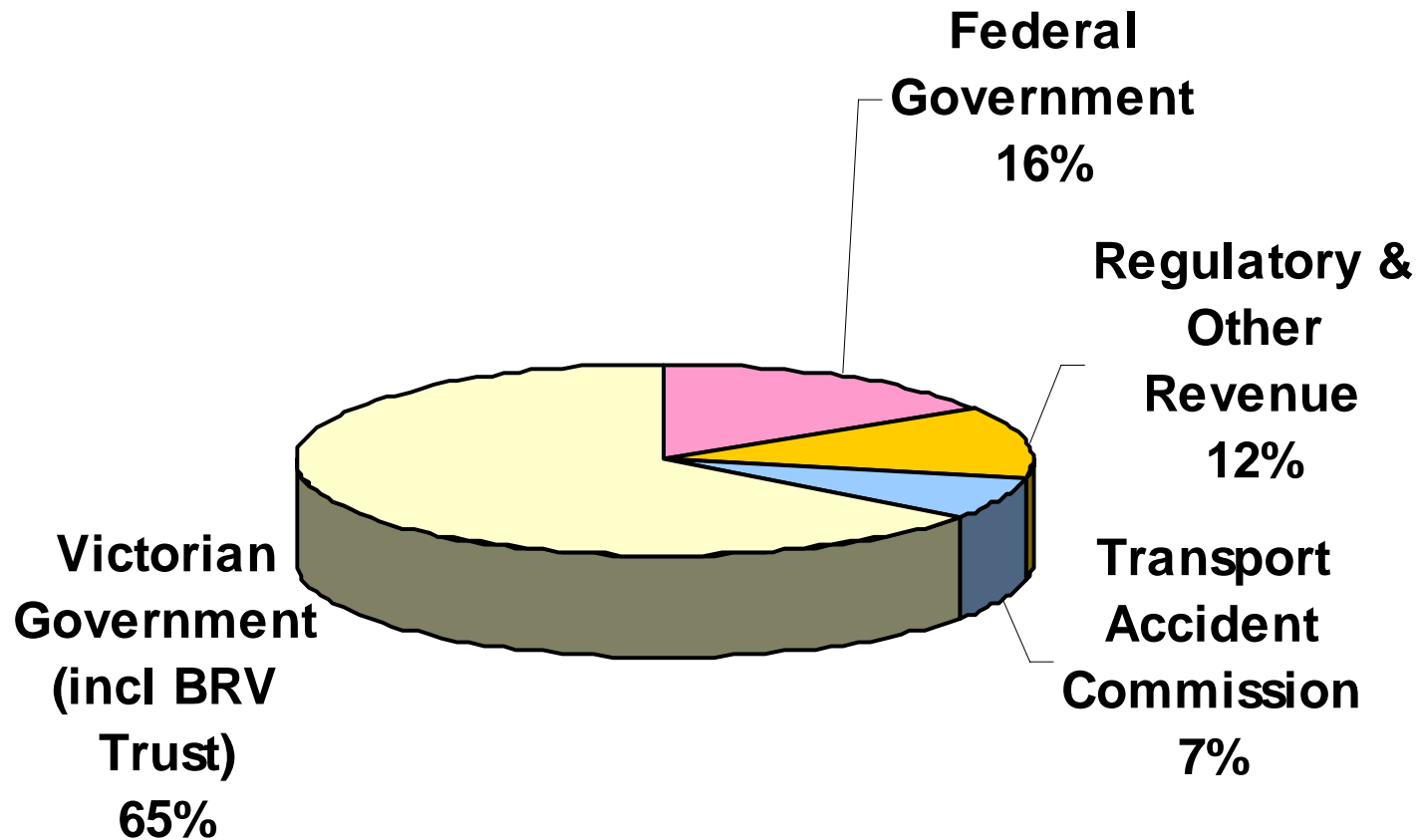


# VicRoads Funding Sources Since 2004-05

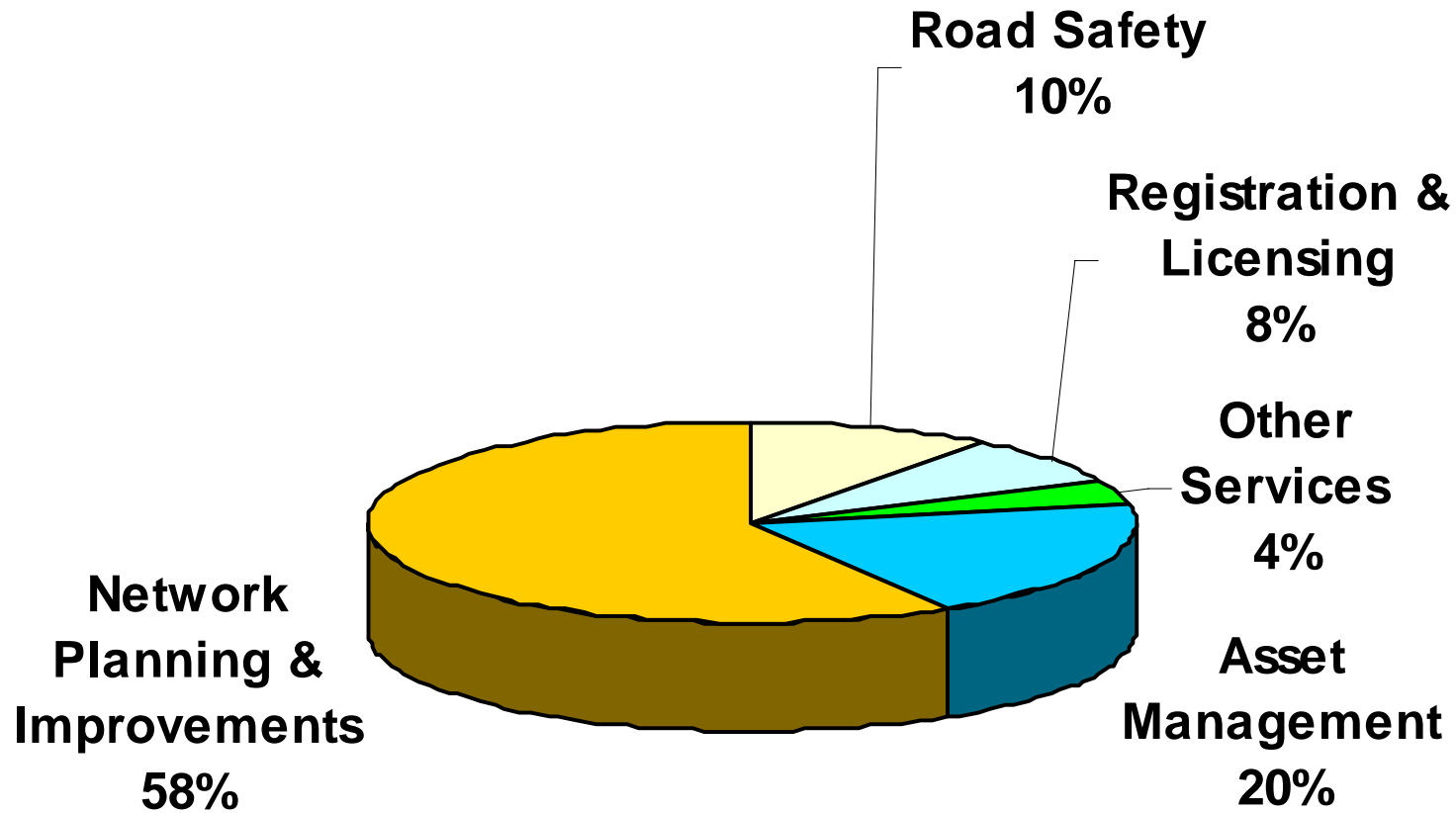

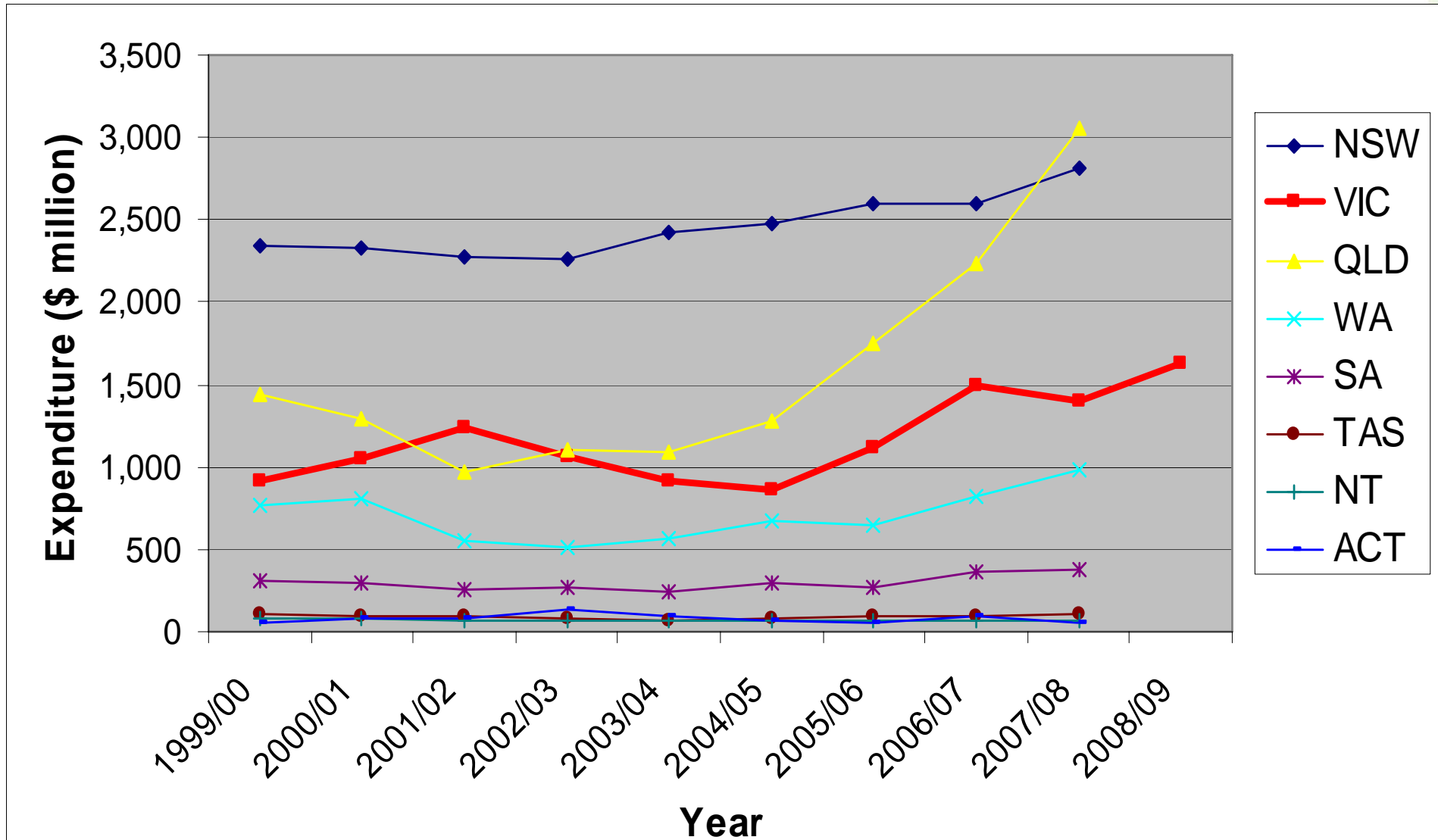

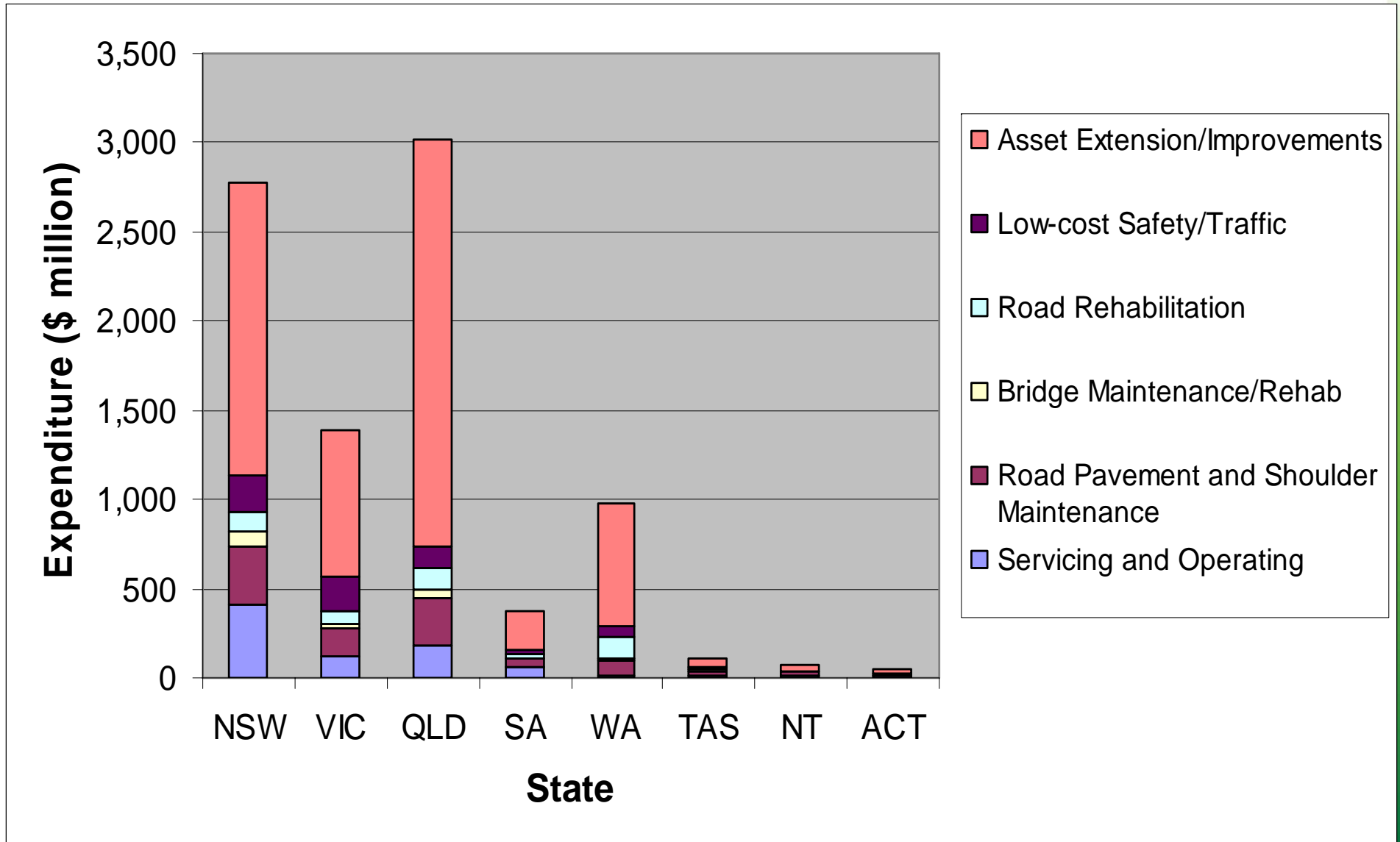

# Total Arterial Road Expenditure by State All Arterial Roads, 2008-09 Prices

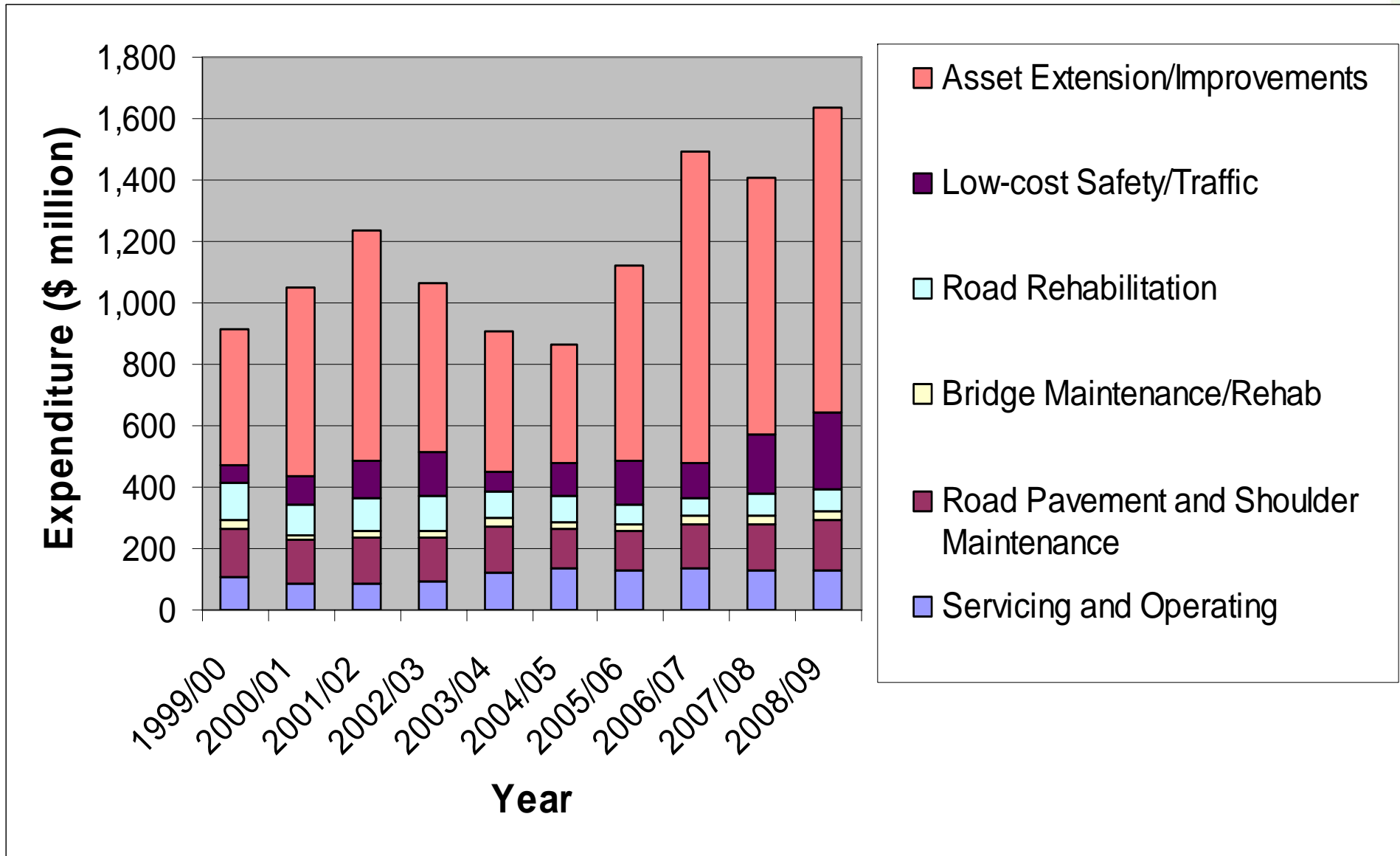


# Arterial Road Expenditure by State 2007-08, All Arterial Roads

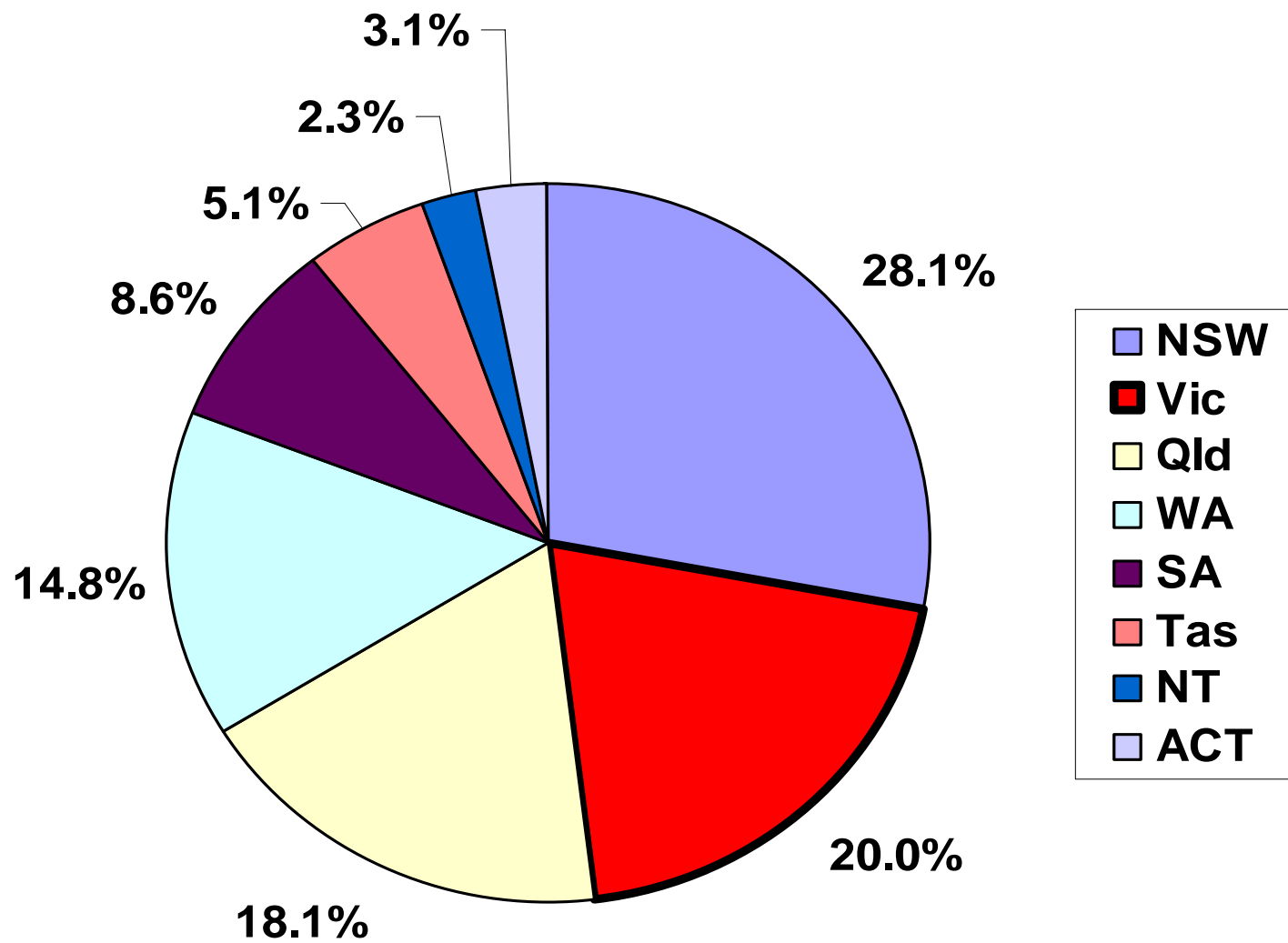


# Victorian Arterial Road Expenditure

## All Arterial Roads, 2008-09 Prices

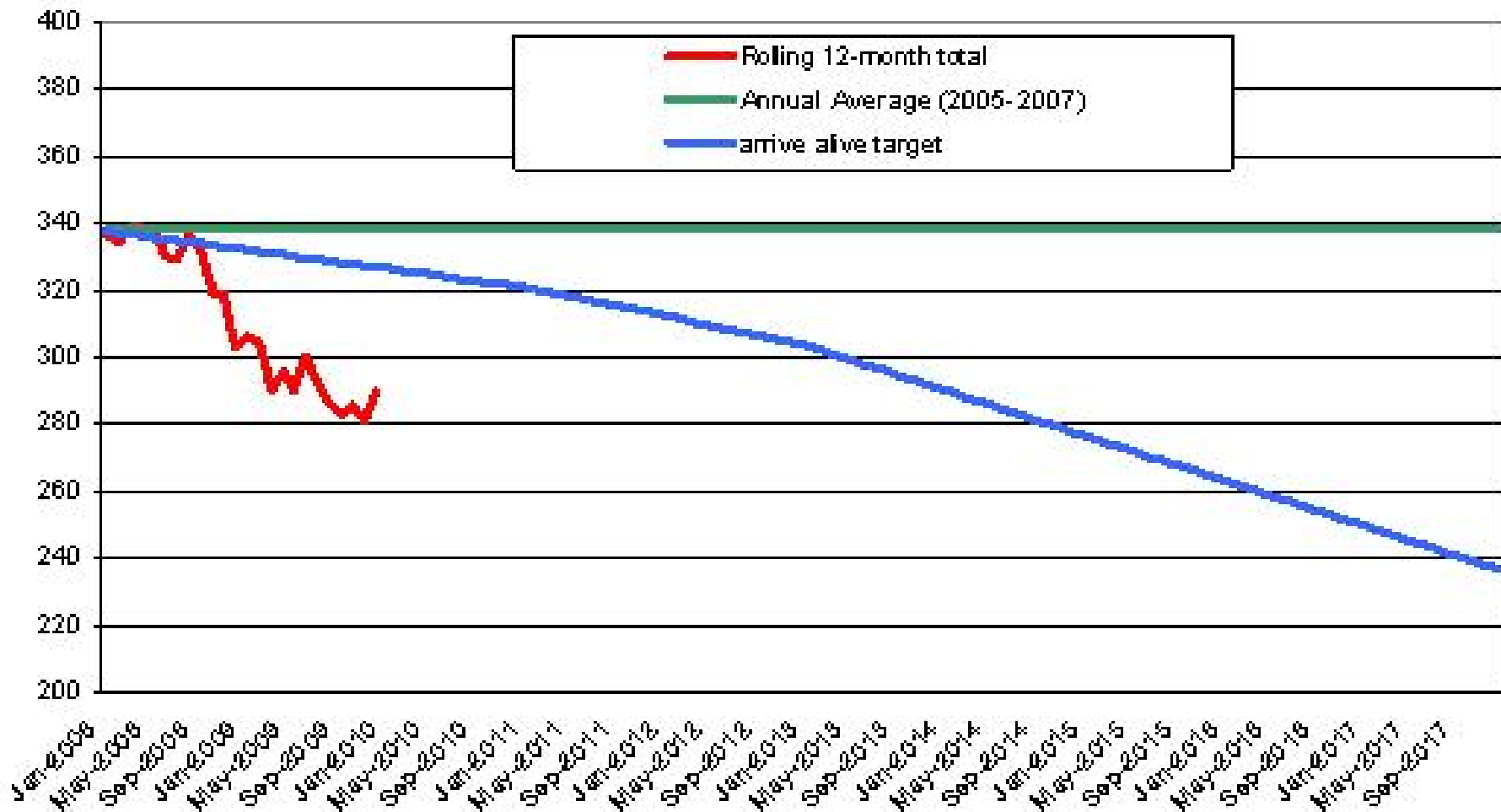

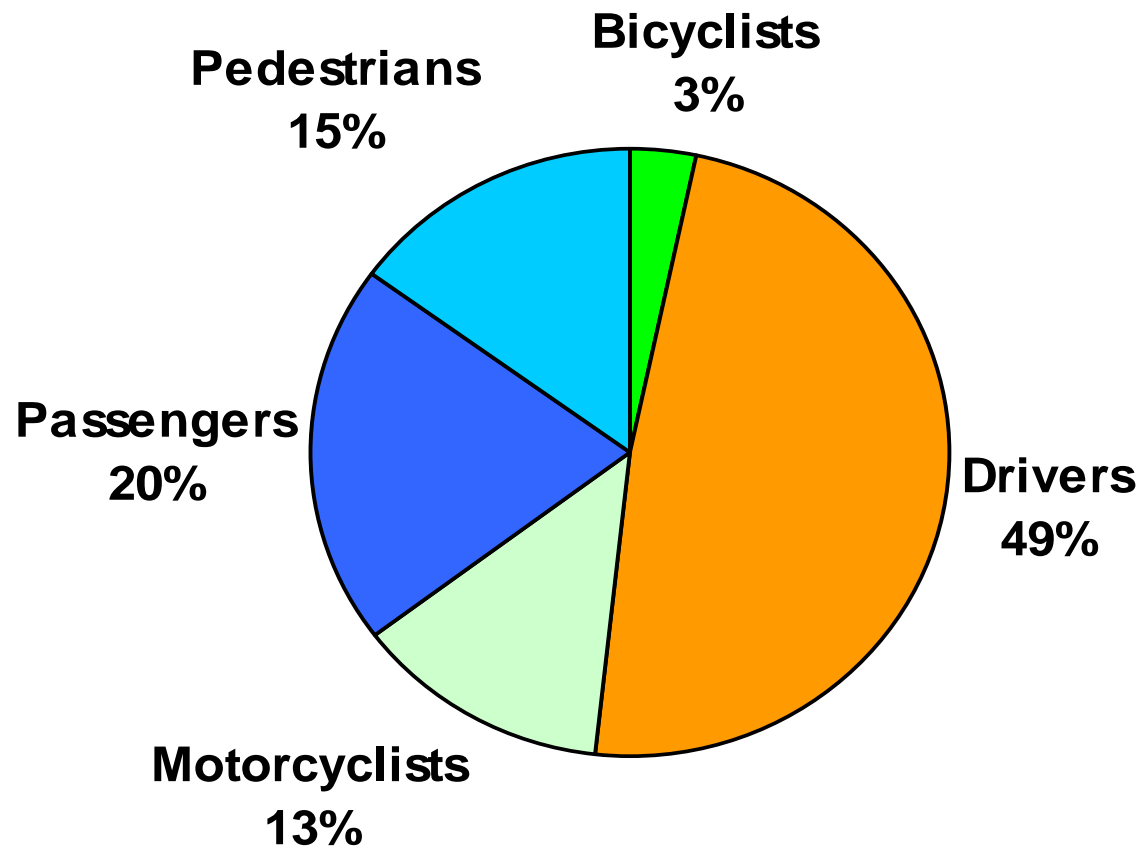
## Road Safety in Victoria

## ■ Opportunities for Improvement

- Victoria strongly supports the Australian Government's new direction in infrastructure planning & investment through Infrastructure Australia, the Building Australia Fund and Nation Building Program
