Conclusion

- Hog deer cause significant damage to young plants at Tidal River
- There is a significant cost in volunteer and ranger hours and operational costs
- Hog deer damage to regrowth, both natural and planted, can be extrapolated to areas throughout the Park
- FOTP supports continuation of Parks Victoria's deer culling program at the Prom and would like to see it extended
- FOTP would not support uncontrolled access to the Park by recreational shooters
