


NSW Grants Commission - Role







(NSW LGGC is constituted under S.613)

Local Roads Component




The National Principles also contain two key principles:

\$18.72 for 2009-10



















NSW Local Road & Bridge Totals






Finally...

The grants are paid by quarterly instalments:


- August
