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Overview

- QLGGC independent body reports directly to Minister for Local Government
- Responsible for making recommendations on the allocation of the Commonwealth Financial Assistance Grant
 - Two components
 - General Purpose Grant \$269.2M 2009/10
 - · Identified Road Grant \$111.3M 2009/10
- Total pool of funds nationally indexed annually in line with CPI and population growth forecasts.
- Role of Commission in state local government legislation needs to operate within Commonwealth legislation



Roads funding

- QLGGC is concerned only with local roads controlled, constructed and maintained by councils
- Identified Road Grant in Queensland based on 62.85% road length and 37.15% population - \$457 per km
- Queensland has 174 522 kms of road length 27.0% of Australia's road length – highest – spread over large area – regional centres



Roads funding

- Grants Commission is only repository of local roads information
- Data updated annually through data collection form
- Road data forms an important element to the GPG calculations
