# Road Safety Amendment (Car Doors) Bill 2012

A Bill for an Act to amend the **Road Safety Act 1986** and the Road Safety (Drivers) Regulations 2009 and for other purposes.

### The Parliament of Victoria enacts:

## 1 Main purpose

The main purpose of this Act is to make it an offence to cause a hazard by opening a door of a vehicle.

#### 2 Commencement

This Act comes into operation on the 28th day after the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

#### 3 New section 64B inserted

After section 64A of the **Road Safety Act 1986** insert—

#### "64B Opening doors of a vehicle

A person must not cause a hazard to any person or vehicle by opening a door of a vehicle, leaving a door of a vehicle open, or getting off, or out of, a vehicle.

Penalty: 10 penalty units.".

## 4 Amendment of Schedule 3 of Road Safety (Drivers) Regulations 2009—demerit points

After item 37 of Schedule 3 to the Road Safety (Drivers) Regulations 2009 **insert**—

"37A Causing a hazard by opening RSA 64B 3" a door of a vehicle, leaving such a door open or getting off, or out of, a vehicle

### 5 Repeal of amending Act

This Act is **repealed** on the first anniversary of the day on which this Act comes into operation.

#### Note

The repeal of this Act does not affect the continuing operation of the amendments made by it (see section 15(1) of the **Interpretation of Legislation Act 1984**).
