Key components of the roads budget

\$8-10 billion for Western Section of East West Link

\$850 million to widen CityLink-Tulla

\$685 million to remove level crossings

\$362 million to further duplicate Princes Hwy West


\$130 million boost to road maintenance spending











Western Section of East West Link – key benefits

- Time savings
- Capacity for around 100,000 vehicles per day
- Relief for the West Gate Bridge which carries around 200,000 vehicles per day.
- Reduced noise and air pollution in the western suburbs.
- The potential for large-scale urban renewal in the west.
- The creation of up to 3000 jobs during construction.


