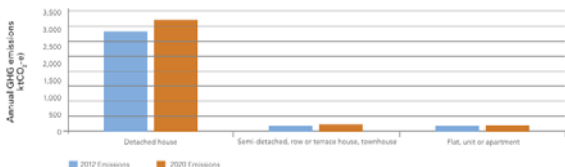

Figure 10 2012 baseline emissions and 2020 projections for residential buildings broken down by dwelling type

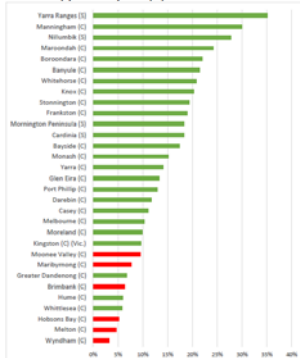

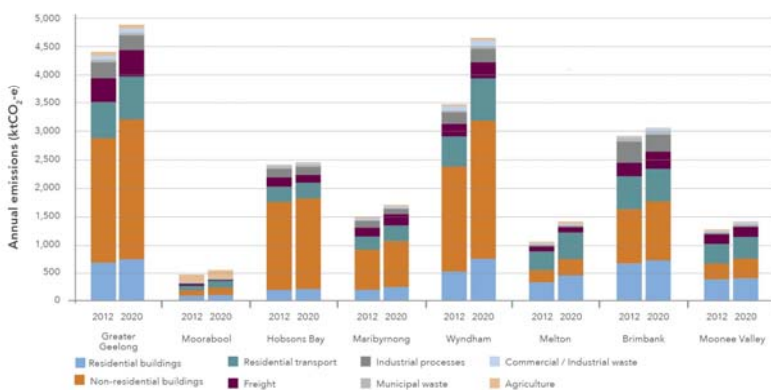
Tree Canopy Cover by LGA (%)

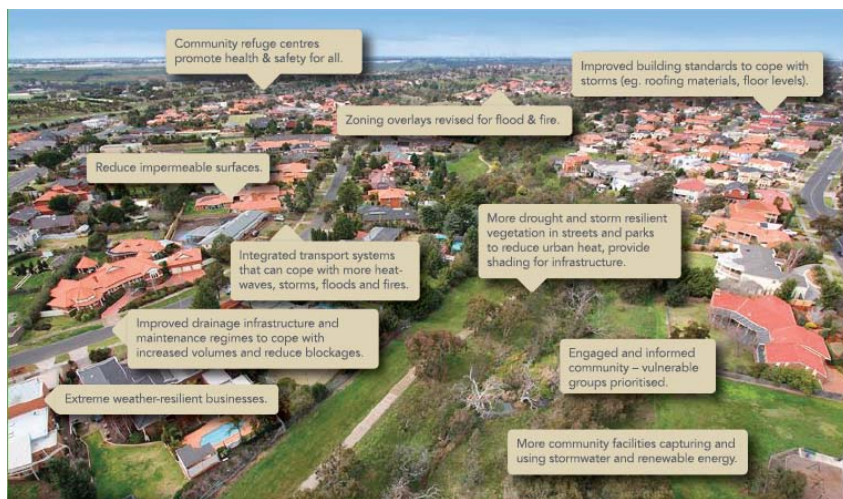
